CONSTITUENCY AND WARD BOUNDARY DESCRIPTIONS FOR CONFIRMATION

1. CHIRADZULU

1.1. CHIRADZULU NYUNGWE CONSTITUENCY

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 47,056.

The constituency comprises the whole area of Traditional Authorities Chitera and Nchemba and part of Traditional Authority Mpama.

The constituency boundary commences at a point where the boundaries of Chiradzulu, Blantyre and Zomba districts converge on the Mlombozi River, thence North Easterly along the Chiradzulu-Zomba district boundary up to point 730777E, 8282848N, thence Southerly along the said district boundary up to a point 731444E, 8280197N at Mathambo Village, thence North Easterly along the same boundary through Chelewani and Selemani Msungwi Villages up to a point 734925E, 8282762N at Mukule Village where it meets Namadzi River, thence South Easterly along the said Namadzi River which is also the Chiradzulu-Zomba district boundary up to point 741386E, 8270332N, where the said river meets the boundary between Traditional Authorities Nchemba and Sandareki, thence South Westerly along the said traditional authority boundary up to the point of where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Nchemba, Kadewere, and Sandareki converge at Roben Village, thence North Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Nchemba and Kadewere up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Nchemba, Mpama and Kadewere converge at Samikwa Village, thence Southerly along the boundary between the Traditional Authorities Mpama and Kadewere up to the point where the said traditional boundary meets the Chiradzulu Forest Reserve boundary at a point 734020E, 8266491N, thence South Westerly along the forest reserve boundary up to point 728295E, 8263414N where the said forest reserve boundary meets an unnamed stream at Katsizi Village, thence Westerly along the said unnamed stream up to a point where it meets M3 Road (John Chilembwe Highway) along the Chiradzulu-Blantyre district boundary at Njuli Trading Centre, thence Northerly along the said district boundary to point where the boundaries of Chiradzulu, Blantyre and Zomba districts converge on the Mlombozi River, which is the point of commencement.

WARDS

(1) Nkhande Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 21,651. It is to the West of the constituency.

(2) Mbulumbuzi Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population 25,405. It is to the East of the of the constituency.

The wards are demarcated by the M3 Road (Blantyre-Zomba Road) which commences at a point where the road intersects with the Chiradzulu-Zomba district boundary at a point 734677E, 8280495N to the point where the said road intersects with the Chiradzulu-Blantyre district at Njuli Trading Centre.

1.2. CHIRADZULU MASANJALA CONSTITUENCY

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 51,162.

The constituency comprises the areas of Traditional Authorities Mpama and Onga, the Boma, part of Traditional Authority Kadewere and part of Traditional Authority Sandareki.

The constituency boundary commences at a point where the boundary between Traditional Authorities Nchema and Sandareki meets the Chiradzulu-Zomba district boundary along Namadzi River, thence South Easterly along Namadzi River up to the point where the boundaries of Chiradzulu, Zomba and Mulanje districts converge, thence Southerly along the Chiradzulu-Mulanje district boundary up to a point approximately 831 metres where it intersects with the S145 at Milepa Trading Centre, thence Westerly along the said road up to its junction with the Milepa-Chikuli Road at Mukiwa Village, thence Westerly along the said Milepa-Chikuli Road passing through Nambazo Trading Centre, through Ndunde CCAP Primary School, Ngoleka, and Malambo Villages up to a point 738259E: 8259753N where it intersects with the boundary between Traditional Authorities Kadewere and Onga, thence South Easterly along the said boundary up to a point where it meets Namboya River, thence South Westerly along the said traditional authority boundary up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Onga, Likoswe, and Kadewere converge, thence Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Onga and Likoswe up to a point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities, Onga, Mpama and Likoswe converge, thence Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Mpama and Likoswe up where it meets the Chiradzulu district-Blantyre City boundary on Mombezi River, thence Northerly along the said boundary up to the point where the boundaries of Chiradzulu and Blantyre Districts and Blantyre City converge, thence Northerly along the Chiradzulu-Blantyre district boundary up to where the said boundary intersects with M3 Road (Limbe-Zomba Road) and meets an unnamed stream, thence Easterly along the said unnamed stream up to the point where it meets the Chiradzulu forest reserve boundary at a point 728295E, 8263414N at Katsizi Village, thence North Easterly along the Chiradzulu Forest Reserve boundary up to point 734020E, 8266491N, where the said Forest Reserve boundary meets the boundary between Traditional Authorities Mpama and Kadewere, thence Northerly along said traditional

authority boundary up to a point 734121E, 8272820N where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Mpama, Nchemba and Kadewere converge at Samikwa Village, thence South Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Mchemba and Kadewere up to a point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Nchemba, Kadewere and Sandareki converge at Roben Village, thence Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Nchemba and Sandareki up to the point where it meets the Chiradzulu-Zomba district boundary along Namadzi River, which is the point of commencement.

WARDS

(1) Mwanje Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 28,836. It is to the North of the constituency.

(2) Mombezi Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 27,326. It is to the South of the constituency.

The wards are demarcated by a boundary which commences at a point 734044E, 8266485N at Nkupu Village, thence South Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Kadewere and Mpama, up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Kadewere, Onga and Mpama converge, thence Southerly along boundary between Traditional Authorities Kadewere and Onga up to the constituency boundary.

1.3. CHIRADZULU THUMBWE CONSTITUENCY

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 43,522.

The constituency comprises areas of Traditional Authorities Sandareki, Kadewere and Mpunga.

The constituency boundary commences at the intersection of S145 Road with the Chiradzulu-Mulanje district boundary, near Milepa Trading Centre, thence Southerly along the said district boundary up to the point it where in meets Mitumbira River, thence North Westerly up to a point 745758E, 8247460N, thence Northerly up to a point 746224E, 8249560N, thence Southerly up to the confluence between Malangalanga and Mitumbira Rivers, thence North Westerly along Malangalanga River up to point 742182E, 8251329N at Kumano Village, then Southerly along the said river up to its confluence with Namulenga River on the boundary between Traditional Authorities Nkalo and Mpunga, thence North Westerly along Namalenga River up to point 7381733E, 8248392N at Magodi Village, thence North Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Nkalo and Mpunga up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Mpunga, Nkalo and Likoswe converge, thence Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Likoswe and Mpunga up to point 737475E, 8249800N at Likovo Village, thence North Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Mpunga and Likoswe up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Kadewere, Mpunga and Likoswe converge, thence North Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Kadewere and Likoswe up to the point

where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Kadewere, Likoswe, Onga converge at a point 735015E, 8255694N, thence Northerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Kadewere and Onga up to the point where it intersects with the Milepa-Chikuli Road at a point 738259E, 8259753N, thence North Easterly along the said road through Malambo and Ngoleka, Villages and Ndunde CCAP Primary School up to Nambazo Village at a point 740812E, 8263940N), thence Easterly along unnamed road up to its junction with S145 Road, thence Easterly along the S145 to its intersection with the Chiradzulu-Mulanje district boundary, near Milepa Trading Centre, which is the point of commencement.

WARDS

(1) Nanjati Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 19,864. It is to the South of the constituency.

(2) Maera Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 23,658. It is to the North of the constituency.

The wards are demarcated by the Robert Mugabe Highway (Blantyre-Midima Road).

1.4. CHIRADZULU NGULUDI CONSTITUENCY

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 44,917.

The constituency comprises the whole area of Traditional Authority Likoswe.

The constituency boundary commences at the point where the boundaries of the Traditional Authorities Likoswe, Kadewere and Onga converge, thence South Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Likoswe and Kadewere up to a point 736533E, 8252659N where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Likoswe, Kadewere and Mpunga converge, thence South Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Likoswe and Mpunga up to Likovo Village at a point 737500E, 8249634N, thence South Westerly along the said traditional boundary up to a point where the boundaries between Traditional Authorities Likoswe, Mpunga and Nkalo converge at a point 736733E, 8249026N, thence South Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Likoswe and Nkalo up to a point where the said traditional boundary meets the Chiradzulu-Thyolo district boundary, thence Westerly along the said district boundary up to the point where the boundaries of Chiradzulu, Blantyre and Thyolo districts converge, thence Westerly along Chiradzulu-Blantyre district boundary up to the point where the boundaries of Chiradzulu and Blantyre districts and Blantyre City converge, thence Northerly along the Chiradzulu-Blantyre City boundary up to the point where it meets the boundary between Traditional Authorities Likoswe and Mpama, thence Easterly along the said traditional authority boundary, passing through Kazombe, Singano, Jekete, Kanyenda and Mlumbe Villages up to a point 731571E, 8257528N which is also the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Mpama, Onga and Likoswe converge, thence South Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Likongwe and Onga up to

the point where the boundaries of the Traditional Authorities Likoswe, Kadewere and Onga converge, which is the commencement point.

WARDS

(1) Chisombezi Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 27,581. It is to the West of the constituency.

(2) Malabvi Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 17,336. It is to the East of the constituency.

The wards are demarcated by a boundary which commences at a point 726039E, 8248488N on the boundary between Traditional Authorities Likoswe and Onga, thence Easterly along the Nguludi Hospital Road up to its junction with M4 Road, thence North Westerly along the M4 Road up to the point where it intersects with the Chiradzulu District-Blantyre City boundary near Zaone Primary School which is on the constituency boundary.

1.5. CHIRADZULU MIDIMA CONSTITUENCY

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 42,974.

The constituency comprises the whole area of Traditional Authority Nkalo and part of Traditional Authority Mpunga.

The constituency boundary commences at a point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Nkalo, Likoswe and Mpunga converge, thence South Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Nkalo and Mpunga up to a point 7381733E, 8248392N, where the said boundary meets Namalenga River at Magodi Village, thence South Easterly along the said boundary and river up to its confluence with Malangalanga River, thence North Easterly along the Malangalanga River up to its confluence with Mitumbira River, thence Northerly up to point 746224E, 8249560N, then South Easterly along up to a point 745758E, 8247460N, South Easterly along the Mitumbira River up to the point it meets the boundary between Chiradzulu-Mulanje boundary, thence Southerly along the said boundary up to a point where the boundaries of Chiradzulu and Mulanje districts and Luchenza Municipality converge and intersect with Thuchila River, thence South Westerly along the Chiradzulu district-Luchenza Municipality boundary which is along Thuchila River up to its confluence with Luchenza River at Nankhumwa Village, thence South Westerly, then North Westerly along Luchenza River, which is also the Chiradzulu-Luchenza Municipality boundary, up to the point where the boundaries of Chiradzulu, Thyolo districts and Luchenza Municipality converge at 745178E, 8231075N, thence North Westerly along Luchenza River, which is also the boundary between Chiradzulu and Thyolo districts, up to a point where it meets the boundary between Traditional Authorities Nkalo and Likoswe, thence North Easterly along the said boundary crossing M4 Road up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Nkalo, Likoswe and Mpunga converge, which is the point of commencement.

WARDS

(1) Mitumbira Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 15,360. It is to the South of the constituency.

(2) Sakata Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 27,614. It is to the North of the constituency.

The wards are demarcated by the M4 (Robert Mugabe Highway) Road.
