



**MALAWI ELECTORAL COMMISSION
REVIEW OF CONSTITUENCY AND WARD BOUNDARIES**

**PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF CONSTITUENCY AND WARD
BOUNDARIES**

DEDZA

Pursuant to its powers under the Constitution of the Republic of Malawi and the Electoral Commission Act, the Commission has determined that the boundaries of the constituencies and wards in Dedza District Council for the purposes of the 2025 Parliamentary and Local Government Elections shall be as follows:

1. CONSTITUENCIES

1.1. DEDZA MTAKATAKA

It comprises the Northern part of Traditional Authority Kachindamoto.

Dedza Mtakataka Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 34,347.

It starts at a point where the M5 Road, intersects the Salima Dedza District boundary, thence Easterly along the District boundary up to the point where the Salima, Dedza District boundary meets Lake Malawi, thence South Easterly passing through Chitukula village along the Lake Malawi Coastline up to an estuary with unnamed stream coordinate

674249E, 8429543N, thence South Westerly along the Stream, up to the confluence with another stream at coordinate 670551E, 8427602N, thence joining an Earth Road South Easterly passing through Mwasinja Village up to point where the Stream intersects with a Road from Mtandamula School, thence South Westerly along the Stream passing through Kawongo Village up to the confluence with Nadzipokwe River thence South Westerly following Nadzipokwe River up to its confluence with Namkhokwe River, thence South Westerly along Nankhokwe River intersecting the Railway line and then M5 Road, up to the boundary of Mua- Livulezi Forest Reserve, thence South Westerly, thence Northerly along the Forest boundary up to the point where the Forest boundary meets the Dedza – Salima Escarpment, thence North Westerly along the Forests boundary, up to where it meets the boundary of Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza. Thence North Westerly along the Salima – Dedza Escarpment which is also the Traditional Authority boundary of Kamenya Gwaza and Kachindamoto up to a point where the boundaries of Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza, Traditional Authority Kachindamoto, Traditional Authority and Traditional Authority Kasumbu meet. Thence North Easterly along Traditional Authority Kasumbu and Kachindamoto boundary, through the Escarpment up to the Salima – Dedza District boundary up to the point where it meets the Traditional Authority Kasumbu and Kachindamoto boundary thence along the District boundary up to the point of commencement.

WARDS

MATOWE WARD AND MANKHAMBA WARD

Matowe Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 15,571.

Mankhamba Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 18,596.

Matowe ward is to the North and Mankhamba to the Southern part of the constituency.

Both Matowe and Mankhamba Wards consists of the Northern part of Traditional Authority Kachindamoto.

The boundary between the two wards, starts at a point where Nadzipulu River intersects the Dedza - Salima Escarpment, thence North Easterly along Nadzipulu River up to M5 Road up to coordinate 663089E, 8427814N, thence Easterly along an Earth Road through Kakhome Village up to M5 Road, thence Northerly along M5 Road up to coordinate 663199E, 8428728N, thence North easterly along an Earth Road up to where it joins Nadzipulu River, thence North Easterly along Nadzipulu River up to its intersection with an Earth Road, From Chadzuwa village thence Southerly along the Earth through Chilule village up to coordinate 665519E, 8429383N, where it intersects with another Earth Road, thence turning Easterly with the Earth Road, crossing the D232, thence proceeding Easterly along the Earth Road, passing through Mlangeni, then through Chatata village, up to coordinate 668987E, 8429004N, thence North Westerly along an Earth Road passing through Msunduzeni village, thence Easterly along the Earth Road, through Balala and Kangwanda villages up to the constituency boundary at coordinate 672786E, 8429086N.

1.2. **DEDZA GOLOMOTI CONSTITUENCY**

It consists of the Southern Part of Traditional Authority Kachindamoto.

Dedza Golomoti Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 44,258.

It consists of the Southern Part of Traditional Authority Kachindamoto.

The boundary commences at an Estuary with unnamed Stream at coordinate 670551E, 8427602N, thence South Easterly along the Coastline up to the point where the coastline meets the District boundary between Mangochi and Dedza. Thence Southerly, along the District boundary of Mangochi and Dedza up to the point where Mangochi, Dedza and Ntcheu District boundaries converge. Thence South Westerly along Dedza Ntcheu boundary crossing the Railway Line, then crossing M5 Road, thence Westerly along the

boundary, up to the point where the District boundary meets boundary between Traditional Authority Kachindamoto and Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza, thence Northerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kachindamoto and Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza through the Mua – Livulezi Forest Reserve up to the point where the Traditional Authority boundary of Kachindamoto and Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza meets the Mua – Livulezi Forest Reserve and Salima - Dedza Escarpment, thence South Easterly through the Mua – Livulezi Forest Reserve and Salima - Dedza Escarpment, thence Southerly along the boundary of Mua – Livulezi Forest Reserve thence North Easterly along the same boundary, thence Southerly along the same boundary, thence North Easterly up to the point where the boundary intersects Nankhokwe River, thence North Easterly along Nankhokwe River, intersecting M5 Road, then the Railway line, up to its confluence with Nadzipokwe River, thence North Easterly along Nadzipokwe River up to its confluence with an unnamed Stream at 671524E 842572N , thence following the Stream North Easterly through Kawongo village up to the intersection with the Earth Road from Mtandamula School, thence North Westerly through Mwasinja Village up to up to the point where it meets an unnamed Stream thence North Easterly at coordinate 670551E, 8427202N, up to the Coastal Line at coordinate 674249E, 8429543N which is the point of commencement.

WARDS

KHWEKHWELELE WARD AND KAPIRI WARD

Khwekhwelele Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 24,604.

Kapiri Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 19, 654.

Khwekhwelele Ward is to the West while Kapiri Ward is to the East of the constituency.

The boundary between the two wards is Livulezi River.

1.3. DEDZA LINTHIPE CONSTITUENCY

Dedza Linthipe Constituency partially covers the Southern part of Traditional Authority Kaphuka.

Dedza Linthipe Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 57, 144.

The boundary starts at a point where T371 Road meets the boundary of Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Chongoni Forest, thence South Easterly along T371 Road which forms the boundary between Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Tambala, up to the converging point of Traditional Authority Tambala, Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Kasumbu. Thence Southerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Kasumbu, up to a point where the boundary intersects a Stream that flows into Bimbiri River. Thence Westerly along the Stream, then joining an Earth Road South Westerly to Chongoni Forest Reserve, thence South Easterly along the Forest boundary, thence South westerly along the same boundary, thence Easterly, thence South Westerly up to the point where boundary joins an Earth Road passing through Kumtelera, Madaudau up to the M1 Road at Kalinyeke/Makofo Turn off. Thence South Easterly along M1 Road passing through Njuchi, up to coordinate 638708E, 8410813N, thence Northerly along an Earth Road from Msampha village, thence Easterly to the boundary between Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Dedza Boma. Thence Southerly along the boundary, then crossing the M1 Road up to a point where boundaries of Traditional Authority Kaphuka, Traditional Authority Kachere and Dedza Bom converge, thence North Westerly along the Traditional Authority boundary to up to a point where the boundary intersects an Earth Road from Chinkhombe School in Mphunda village thence Northerly along the Earth Road up to coordinate 612172E, 8423070N thence Easterly along the Earth Road through Mtambala up to Msunduzi River, thence Northerly along Msunduzi River to the confluence with a Stream in Mwataika village, thence Easterly along the Stream to its Source, and joins an Earth Road South Easterly, then North Westerly passing Kapeta, Mtembe villages, up to S126 Road, thence Northerly along S126 Road to the M1 Road, thence South Easterly along M1

Road up to Linthipe 2 Bridge. Thence South Easterly up to the boundary of Chongoni Forest Reserve, thence North Easterly to the point of commencement.

WARDS

CHIMBIYA WARD AND KAMPINI WARD

Chimbiya Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 27,057.

Kampini Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 30,087.

Chimbiya Ward is to the West and Kampini Ward is to the East

Both Chimbiya and Kampini wards are in Traditional Authority Kaphuka.

The boundary between the two wards starts from the point where Linthipe River meets Chongoni Forest Reserve, thence South Easterly along Linthipe River along the Forest Reserve boundary, thence South Westerly along an Earth Road crossing M1 Road at Chimbiya Trading Centre, proceeding to Thete, through Balusu, Huwa, Elia Chimtengo, thence North-westerly along an earth Road through Solizala Village up to Thiwi River at Kapakasa Village, thence North-westerly along Thiwi River to its confluence with Luwenga River, thence South-westerly to Luwenga River then joins D217 Road , thence North-westerly along the D217 Road up to the junction with S126 at Thete Trading Centre , thence North-westerly along an earth road to the constituency boundary.

1.4. DEDZA MAYANI CONSTITUENCY

It comprises of the whole of Traditional Authority Tambala and the North - Eastern part of Traditional Authority Chauma.

Dedza Mayani Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 58,606.

The boundary commences at the converging point of Dedza, Lilongwe and Salima Districts at Linthipe River, thence South Easterly along Dedza- Salima boundary up to the a point where the boundary of Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Kasumbu meets at Lifisi River, thence Southerly along the boundary up to the point where Traditional Authority Tambala, Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Kasumbu converge, thence North Westerly along Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Kasumbu boundary up to the converging point of Traditional Authority Tambala, Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Chauma, thence Northerly following the boundary of Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Chauma up to the point where a tributary of Livuwadzi River intersects the Traditional Authority boundary at Biwi James village, thence Westerly following an unnamed stream up to its confluence with Livuwadzi River. Thence North westerly along Livuwadzi River up to its confluence with a Stream at coordinate 625712E, 8443708N thence Westerly following the Stream to its source, thence Southerly along an Earth Road, joining to T373 Road at Kumfera village, thence Westerly along T373 Road up to Mikundi School, where it joins an Earth Road to Mwanza thence North Westerly along the Road up to its confluence with Linthipe River which is also district boundary between Dedza and Lilongwe District, thence Northerly along the District boundary to the commencing point.

WARDS

CHITUNDU WARD AND TCHETSA WARD

Chitundu Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 29,332.

Tchetsa Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 29,274.

Tchetsa Ward is to the North and Chitundu Ward to the South of the constituency.

Chitundu Ward covers the Southern part of Traditional Authority Tambala and Tchetsa ward covers the Northern part of Traditional Authority Tambala and North-Eastern part of Traditional Authority Chauma

The boundary between the two wards starts at coordinate 645974E, 8450206N a point where the Dedza Salima Escarpment boundary meets the boundary of Traditional Authority Kasumbu and Traditional Authority Tambala thence Westerly, following the Forest Reserve boundary along a stream up to a point where the Stream leaves the Forest Reserve, thence Westerly along the Stream through Kadzibwa, Dzuwa, and Katete Villages, thence joining an Earth Road at Katete, thence South-easterly along the Road through Nsalanyama, thence joining T375 Road Mphalabungu village thence Southerly along the Road up to Mayani Trading Centre, thence Westerly up to Ngolonje Village, then joins an Earth Road Southern Westerly along the Earth Road up to Matenje Village up thence Southerly through Kayesera Village to the Constituency boundary.

1.5. **DEDZA KASINA CONSTITUENCY**

It covers the South-western part of Traditional Authority Chauma, North-western part of Traditional Authority Kaphuka.

Dedza Kasina Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 56,501.

The boundary commences at the point where the Dedza and Lilongwe District boundaries meets an Earth Road at Mwanza village, thence South-easterly along the Earth Road up to Mikundi School where it joins T373 Road, thence Easterly along the T373 Road up to Kumfera Village, thence Northerly joining an Earth Road to the source of Stream at Tsoyo Village , thence Easterly along the Stream to Coordinate 625712E, 8443708N. Thence Easterly up to the confluence of with Livuwadzi River, thence South-easterly along Livuwadzi River up to the confluence with a Stream, thence Easterly to a point of intersection with Traditional Authority boundary between Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Chauma through Biwi James village, thence Southerly along the

boundary between Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Chauma, up to the converging point of Traditional Authority Tambala, Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Chauma, thence South Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Kaphuka, up to a point where the boundary meets T371 Road which is also the Chongoni Forest Reserve boundary, thence South Westerly along the Chongoni Forest Reserve boundary up to where the said Forest Reserve boundary meets Linthipe River. Thence North westerly along Linthipe river up to Linthipe 2 Bridge along the M1 Road, thence North Westerly along the M1 Road up to the junction with S126 Road, thence South-westerly along S126 Road, through Phwere, Mlamba, Mbidzi villages up to the junction with an Earth Road to Mwataika Dzandi Village at coordinate 617822E, 8425080N, thence Westerly to Msunduzi River, through Mtembe and Mwataika villages, thence Southerly along Msunduzi River up to where it intersects with an Earth Road at Coordinate 613750E, 8422945N, thence South Westerly along an Earth Road, through Mtambala School, up to its intersection with Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Kachere boundary at coordinate 614036E, 8422046N. Thence North Westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Kachere up to the converging point of Traditional Authority Kaphuka, Traditional Authority Kachere and Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo, thence North-westerly along the boundary Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo up to the District boundary with Lilongwe, thence North-easterly along the District boundary, crossing the M1Road to the commencement point.

WARDS

MKUNDI WARD AND CHITOWO WARD

Mkundi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 30,237.

Chitowo Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 26,264.

Mkundi Ward is to the North-East and Chitowo Ward is to the South-West.

The wards are in the Northern part of Traditional Authority Kaphuka, and the South-West of Traditional Authority Chauma.

The boundary for the two Wards commences at the confluence of Linthipe and Diamphwe Rivers, thence South Easterly along Linthipe River up to its confluence with a Stream at coordinate 620817E, 8434868N, thence Westerly following the Stream to the Intersection point with D220 Road thence Northerly along D220 Road up to its junction with an Earth Road at Kasina Trading Centre, thence Easterly along the Road up to its intersection with D221 Road, thence South-easterly along Dzenza Forest Reserve boundary at Nteke village , thence Southerly along the Dzenza Forest Reserve boundary, thence Westerly intersecting an Earth Road to T372 Road, thence Southerly along Linthipe River up to Linthipe 2 bridge which is the constituency boundary.

1.6. **DEDZA CHIKOMA CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency covers the entire Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo and the Northern part of Traditional Authority Kachere.

Dedza Chikoma Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 55,794.

The boundary starts at a point where the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo meets the District boundary of Dedza and Lilongwe along Diamphwe River, thence Southerly along Msunduzi River up to its confluence with Kaphya River, thence Southwards then South-west along Kaphya River up to its source, then Joining an Earth Road to the Boundary of Traditional Authority Kachere and Chilikumwendo, thence South Westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo and Traditional Authority Kachere , up to Dzalanyama Forest Reserve, thence North Westerly along the said Forest Reserve boundary with Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo, up to the Lilongwe – Dedza District boundary, thence North-easterly along the District boundary to the point of commencement.

WARDS

KABWAZI WARD AND MAGOMERO WARD

Kabwazi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 26,265.

Magomero Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 29,529.

Kabwazi Ward is to the North and Magomero Ward to the South of the Constituency.

Kabwazi Ward covers the northern part of Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo and the Northern part of Traditional Authority Kachere. Magomero Ward covers the Southern part of Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo.

The two Wards are separated from by S124 Road. The Road starts from Chamangwana Village passing through Kanyezi Trading Centre, Dambe Village to Lumwira village.

1.7. DEDZA BOMA CONSTITUENCY

The area of the constituency covers the whole area of Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza, Dedza Boma and Part of Traditional Authority Kaphuka, and the Southwestern part of Traditional Authority Kasumbu.

Dedza Boma constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 59,222.

The boundary starts at a point where the boundaries of Traditional Authority Kasumbu, Kamenya Gwaza and Kachindamoto converge. Thence Southerly along the boundary between Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza and Traditional Authority Kachindamoto through Mua-Livurezi Forest Reserve, up to the District boundary with Ntcheu and Dedza. Thence North-westerly along the District boundary of Ntcheu and Dedza up to Masasa Village where the district boundary meets the Mozambique and Malawi international

boundary formed by the M1 Road, thence North-westerly up to the point where Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza and Dedza Boma meets the international boundary between Malawi and Mozambique along the M1 Road, thence South-westerly along the said international boundary up to the point where the boundary between the Boma and International boundary meets Traditional Authority Kachere, thence Northerly along the boundary between Traditional Authority Kachere and Boma up to the point where T/A Kaphuka, Kachere and the Boma converge. Thence Northerly along TA Kaphuka and Boma boundary intersecting the M1 Road at coordinate 639742E, 8410259N in Dauya Village thence Northerly along T/A Kaphuka and Boma boundary up to coordinate 639943E, 8411076N where the boundary joins an earth road, thence Westerly along the Road through Dauya village up to coordinate 638888E, 8411404N thence southerly along the road up to M1 Road, thence North Westerly along M1 Road up to Kalinyeke – Makofu Turn Off thence northerly along the Earth Road passing through Madaudau and Kumtelela Villages up to the boundary of Chongoni Forest Reserve, thence North-easterly along the Chongoni Forest Reserve boundary up to coordinate 636465E, 8419268N, thence North-easterly along the Earth Road up to a Stream that flows into Bimbili River, thence South-easterly along the stream, up to the boundary between Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Kasumbu, thence Northerly along the Traditional Authority boundary, up to a point where the boundary meets an Earth Road, to Kanyada Village at coordinate 637044E, 8425316N, thence Easterly along the Earth Road to the point of intersection with Lifisi River, thence Southerly along Lifisi River up to its confluence with Bimbili river at Mkomeko School, thence South-easterly along Bimbili River up to its confluence with a stream (200metres), thence South-easterly along the Stream to its source, thence Easterly joining the D228 Road, thence Southerly along D228 Road up to Magunditsa Village, thence Westerly along the Earth Road up to coordinate 642302E, 8421653N, thence South-easterly passing through Chiphe village up to Dedza Mountain Forest Reserve. Thence Easterly along the Forest Reserve boundary, thence South-easterly through Kasumbu CDSS up to the boundary between Boma and Forest Reserve, thence Easterly along the Boma and Traditional Authority Kasumbu boundary up to the point where boundaries of, Traditional Authority Kasumbu, Kamenya Gwaza and Boma converge. Thence Easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kasumbu and

Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza, thence North-easterly along the boundary up to the point of commencement.

WARDS

UMBWI WARD AND BEMBEKE WARDS

Umbwi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 28,061.

Bembeke ward has a projected eligible voter population of 31,161.

Umbwi Ward is to the West and Bembeke ward to the East of the constituency.

Umbwi Ward covers the Southwestern part of Traditional Authority Kasumbu, Western part of Boma and South-eastern part of Traditional Authority Kaphuka. Bembeke ward covers the whole area of Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza and the Eastern part of Boma.

The boundary that separates the two wards commences at the point where T374 Road intersects the boundary of Boma and Dedza Forest Reserve, thence South-westerly along Boma and Dedza Forest Reserve boundary, thence Southerly along an Earth Road that passes through Dedza Golf Club, Dedza PTC up to Umbwi secondary School crossing M1 Road up to the district boundary which is the constituency boundary and also the international boundary between Malawi and Mozambique.

1.8. DEDZA MLUNDUNI CONSTITUENCY

The constituency covers the Northern and South-eastern part of Traditional Authority Kasumbu.

Dedza Boma constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 58,932.

The boundary commences at a point where Salima District, Traditional Authority Kasumbu and Traditional Authority Tambala converge, thence South Easterly along the same Salima – Dedza District boundary, up to the point where Salima District boundary, Traditional Authority Kasumbu, Traditional Authority Kachindamoto converge. Thence South-westerly along Traditional Authority Kachindamoto and Traditional Authority Kasumbu, proceeding with the boundary between Traditional Authority Kasumbu and Kamenya Gwaza up to the point where boundaries of Dedza Boma, Traditional Authority Kamenya Gwaza and Traditional Authority Kasumbu converge. Thence North Westerly along the Dedza Mount Forest Reserve, joining an Earth Road the goes to Mkomeko village, then joining Bimbili River to its confluence with Lifisi River. Thence Northerly joining the Earth Road Westerly to Kanyada village, up to the boundary between Traditional Authority Kaphuka and Traditional Authority Kasumbu, thence Northerly up to the point where Traditional Authority Kasumbu, Traditional Authority Tambala, and Traditional Authority Kaphuka converge, thence North-easterly along Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Kasumbu to the commencement point.

WARDS

DZINDEVU WARD AND MAKOTA WARD

Makota Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 29,834.

Dzindevu Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 29,098.

Dzindevu Ward is to the North and Makota Ward is to the South of the Constituency

Both Dzindevu and Makota Ward are in Traditional Authority Kasumbu

The two wards are separated by a Road at coordinate 654227E, 8425059N, thence South-westerly passing starting at Mzinga village through Chigome village and Mwatonga Village, thence intersecting D227 Road. Westerly up to Mwatonga Village, Northerly following the Earth road through Mlunduni School up to Nampalo Village and thereafter crossed D226 Road through Sosola to Mpotola Village joining T374 Road at Makhunyula village, thence Northerly along T374 up to Kaimfa Village and branching off at Kaimfa Village North-westerly through Mpango to Chimbuzi villages, thence South-westerly through Samama village up to the point where it joins the Traditional boundary between Traditional Authority Tambala and Traditional Authority Kasumbu at coordinate 636312E, 8432750N.

1.9. **DEDZA MPHUNZI CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency covers Eastern part of Traditional Authority Kachere.

Dedza Mphunzi Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 50,446.

The boundary starts from a point where Msunduzi River intersects the boundary between Traditional Authority Kachere and Traditional Authority Kaphuka, thence South-easterly along the boundary up to the point where Traditional Authority Kaphuka, Kachere and Dedza Boma converge, thence Southerly crossing S124 to the boundary between Traditional Authority Kachere and Dedza Boma up to the International boundary of Malawi and Mozambique, thence South Westerly along the International boundary up to the point where it meets the Road to Liabunya Primary School at coordinate 614416E, 8398367N, thence Northerly along the Road through Mpasila, Sere, Nyama villages up to the confluence of Msunduzi and Ngowe Rivers, thence Northerly along Msunduzi, through Livinza and Bamusi villages up to the point of commencement.

WARDS

LOBI WARD AND THETE WARD

Lobi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 25,225.

Thete Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 25,221.

Lobi ward is to the West and Thete to the East of the constituency.

Both Thete and Lobi Wards are to the Eastern part of Traditional Authority Kachere.

The boundary for the two wards commences at a point where D216 Road intersects Msunduzi River, thence North easterly along D216 Road up to its intersection point with S126 Road, thence South Easterly joining an Earth Road from the point of intersection South Easterly along the Road up to the point where it joins Luwenga River, thence Southwards along Luwenga River up to Matchinini village where it joins the D218 Road, thence South-easterly up to Lombwandire thence joining an earth Road through Nyenyela village up to the International boundary between Malawi and Mozambique which is the constituency boundary.

1.10. **DEDZA DZALANYAMA CONSTITUENCY**

This constituency covers the Western part of Traditional Authority Kachere. This constituency also covers part of Dzalanyama Forest Reserve.

Dedza Dzalanyama Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 53,164.

The boundary starts from the confluence of Msunduzi and Kaphya Rivers, thence Southerly along Msunduzi River, up to its confluence with Ngowe River, thence joining an Earth Road at Nyama through Kauma, Sere, Mpasila, Lasani up to the International Boundary, thence Westerly along the international the boundary through Dzalanyama Forest Reserve, up to the point where Dedza and Lilongwe District boundary meets the Malawi and Mozambique international boundary. Thence Northerly along the Dedza - Lilongwe District boundary up to the point of convergence with the boundary of Traditional

Authority Chilikumwendo and Traditional Authority Kachere, thence Easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Chilikumwendo and Traditional Authority Kachere up to coordinate 608912E, 8412869N, where an Earth Road from Ngombengo village intersects the Traditional Authority boundary, thence North Easterly along the earth road through Ngombengo, Nanseta, Nguluwe Villages up to the source of Kaphya River at Kachipewa village, thence Northerly along Kaphya River up to its confluence with Msunduzi River which is the point of commencement.

WARDS

KAFERE WARD AND CHIMOTO WARD

Kafere Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 24,334.

Chimoto Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 28,830.

Kafere Ward is to the West and Chimoto Ward to the East.

Both wards are to the Western part of Traditional Authority Kachere.

The boundary between the wards starts at coordinate 603333E, 8410841N where an earth road intersects the Constituency boundary , thence Southerly along the Earth Road up to D210 Road, thence South Easterly up to its intersection with a Stream in Kasese village , thence Westerly along the Stream up to its confluence with Kambirimбири River, thence Southerly along the River, up to a confluence with a tributary in Kamwendo village, thence South Easterly along the tributary through Moffat village up to the International boundary of Malawi and Mozambique which is the Constituency boundary.
