



**ELECTORAL COMMISSION  
REVIEW OF CONSTITUENCY AND WARD BOUNDARIES  
PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF CONSTITUENCY AND WARD  
BOUNDARIES**

**KASUNGU MUNICIPALITY**

Pursuant to its powers under the Constitution of the Republic of Malawi and the Electoral Commission Act, the Commission has determined that the boundaries of the constituencies and wards in Kasungu Municipal Council for the purposes of the 2025 Parliamentary and Local Government Elections shall be as follows:

**1. CONSTITUENCY**

**1.1. KASUNGU MUNICIPALITY**

Kasungu Central has a projected eligible voter population of 40,096

The Constituency comprises of the whole area of Kasungu Municipal Council as published in the *Gazette*.

**2. WARDS**

**2.1. NGULUYANAWAMBE WARD**

Nguluyanawambe Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 4,599.

The boundary commences at the point where Chankhanga River intersects M1 Road; thence South-easterly along M1 Road through Puma Filling Station, Kasungu Stadium up to the boundary of Kasungu Municipal Council boundary and Traditional Authority

Kaomba; thence Westerly along the boundary, up to the point where boundaries of the Traditional Authority Lukwa and Kaomba converge with the Municipal Council boundary; thence North-westerly to the boundary of the Municipal Council, Traditional Authority Lukwa and Traditional Authority Mwase converge; thence Westerly along the boundary with Traditional Authority Lukwa up to the point where the boundary of Traditional Authority Lukwa, Traditional Authority Mwase and Kasungu Municipality converge; thence Westerly along Kasungu Municipality converge with Traditional Authority Mwase, up to the point where it joins Chankhanga River; thence North-easterly along the boundary with Traditional Authority Mwase along Chankhanga River up to coordinate 549103E, 8559647N; thence Easterly along Chankhanga River up to M1 Road which is the point of commencement.

## 2.2. **CHANKHANGA WARD**

Chankhanga Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 4, 394.

The boundary starts from a point where M1 Road, near Meru Filling station at coordinate 550104E, 8560081N; thence South-easterly along the Road up to a point where it joins T338 Road at Kasungu District Hospital; thence Southerly up to the junction with the M1 Road at Puma Filling Station, thence North-westerly along M1 Road to the point of commencement.

## 2.3. **CHIMPHANGWE WARD**

Chimphangwe Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 3,596.

The boundary starts at a point where boundaries of Traditional Authority Kaomba, Traditional Authority Mwase, and Kasungu Municipality converge; thence Easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and the Municipality, up to coordinate 551909E, 8562305N, near ADD Staff Houses; thence Easterly along the Earth Road up to coordinate 551980E, 8561529N; thence Easterly along the Earth Road, joining a Stream that flows into another Stream; thence South easterly along the Stream to its confluence with another Stream, thence South Westerly along the Stream

up to coordinate 552115E, 8560165N, which is the confluence of with Msambaimfa Stream; thence Westerly along Msambaimfa Stream up to coordinate 551353E, 85602118N; thence joining an Earth Road along the Ring Road up to Juma Trading Center, thence North westerly along the Ring Road up to its junction with M1 Road at Meru filling Station; thence South-easterly along M1 Road up to Chankhanga River, up to the Municipal Council boundary with Traditional Authority Mwase, thence Northwesterly; thence Northerly up to the M1 Road; thence Northerly along M1 Road up to the point of commencement.

#### 2.4. **BUNDA WARD**

Bunda Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 4, 254.

The boundary starts at a point where Chitete River joins the boundary between the Kasungu Municipality boundary and Traditional Authority Kaomba at coordinate 554022E, 8562265N, Southerly along the Municipality boundary up to coordinate 554274E, 8559895N, joining Kasalika Road; thence South Westerly along Kasalika Road up to M18 Road up to the point where the boundary joins Chitete River; thence Northerly along Chitete River, thence North-easterly up to its confluence with a Stream; thence North-westerly along the Stream up to coordinate 552264E, 8561485N where the stream joins an Earth Road to ADD Staff houses; thence Westerly, thence Northerly up to Municipality boundary with Traditional Authority Kaomba at ADD Staff houses; thence Easterly along the municipality boundary with Traditional Authority Kaomba up to commencement.

#### 2.5. **BELELE WARD**

Belele Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 1, 485.

The boundary starts from the confluence of Chankhanga and Chitete Rivers, thence Southerly along Chitete River up to the M18 Road, thence North-westerly along the M18 Road up to coordinate 551041E, 8589991N, where the boundary joins the Ring Road, thence North-westerly up to the point where it joins the Earth Road at Juma Trading Centre, thence Easterly up to the point where it joins Chankhanga River, thence

North-easterly up to the confluence with Chitete River, which is the point of commencement.

## 2.6. **KATOPE WARD**

Katope Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 3,372.

The boundary commences at a point with coordinate 554502E, 8559771N at the confluence of Kaswalipande River and Katope Stream; thence Southerly along Katope Stream, joining an Earth Road at coordinate 554428E, 8559018N at Kasalika Trading Centre; thence Westerly along the Earth Road up to coordinate 553816E, 8558992N, thence Southerly up to the junction with M18 Road, thence Westerly along M18 Road up to Chibowa at coordinate 552887E, 8559089N; thence North-easterly up to coordinate 553807E, 8559767N, where it joins a Road, thence Northerly up to coordinate 553784E, 8559885N; thence Easterly along the Road up to Kasungu Municipality boundary with Traditional Authority Kaomba at coordinate 554272E, 8559892N, thence South-easterly along the Municipality boundary up to the point of commencement.

## 2.7. **KABVUNGUTI WARD**

Kabvunguti Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 3,538.

The boundary commences at the junction of M18 Road and T338 Road at Kasungu Police Station; thence South easterly along M18 Road, up to the point where it intersects with an Earth Road at coordinate 553364E, 8558468N; thence Westerly up to a point with coordinate 533202E, 85584460N; thence Southerly through Chitete Market, thence Westerly up to Chitete River, thence South -westerly up to the Dam, then proceeding to the Municipal Council boundary with Traditional Authority Kaomba; thence Westerly up to the M1 Road; thence North-westerly along M1 Road up to its junction with T338 Road; thence North-easterly along T338 Road up to the point of commencement.

## 2.8. **CHITHIBA WARD**

Chithiba Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 3,766.

The boundary commences at a point with coordinate 533202E, 8558460N, at Merat Private School along M18 Road up to its junction with Chiwengo Road at Gundani, thence South-easterly along Chiwengo Road up to its junction with Tambala Road, thence Southerly-westerly along Ntambala Road up to Kandodo Bridge; thence North easterly along Chitete Rivers up to coordinate 533030E, 8558160N, joining an Earth Road, thence Easterly, thence Northerly, through Chitete Market; thence Easterly up to the point of commencement at the M1 Road.

#### 2.9. **KASWALIPANDE WARD**

Kaswalipande Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 4,687.

The boundary commences at the confluence of Katope Stream and Kaswalipande River. Thence South-easterly along Kaswalipande River, which is the boundary between Kasungu Municipality and Traditional Authority Kaomba; thence South-easterly up to the point where the boundary joins Chiwengo Road; thence South-westerly along Chiwengo Road, up to its junction with M18 Road; thence North westerly along M18 Road up to its junction with an Earth Road at coordinate 553767E, 8558105N; thence Northerly along the Earth Road through Maplot Area, up to Katope Stream; thence Northerly along Katope Stream up to the point of commencement which is the confluence with Kaswalipande River.

#### 2.10. **MNTHAWIRA WARD**

Mnthawira Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 6,405.

The boundary starts from a point where Chiwengo Road meets the Kasungu Municipality boundary with Traditional Authority Kaomba, thence South easterly along the boundary; thence South westerly up to Chitete River (Dam); thence North westerly along Chitete River up to Kandodo Bridge, thence North-easterly along

Ntambalala Road; thence joining Chiwengo Road; thence North Easterly along Chiwengo Road up to the point of commencement.
