



**MALAWI ELECTORAL COMMISSION  
REVIEW OF CONSTITUENCY AND WARD BOUNDARIES**

**PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF CONSTITUENCY AND WARD  
BOUNDARIES**

**KASUNGU DISTRICT**

Pursuant to its powers under the Constitution of the Republic of Malawi and the Electoral Commission Act, the Commission has determined that the boundaries of the constituencies and wards in Kasungu District Council for the purposes of the 2025 Parliamentary and Local Government Elections shall be as follows:

**1. CONSTITUENCIES**

**1.1. KASUNGU NORTH**

*This constituency covers the whole of Sub Traditional Authority Chisikwa, Traditional Authorities Kaluluma and Chisemphere and part of Traditional Authority M'nyanja.*

Kasungu North has a projected eligible voter population of 46,468.

The constituency starts from the point where M1 road intersects the district boundary of Mzimba and Kasungu. Thence Easterly along the boundary up to the point of converge of boundaries of Sub Traditional Authority Chisikwa and Sub Traditional Authority Kaluluma, thence North Easterly along the same district boundary; thence South Westerly up to the point where Kasungu and Mzimba district boundary tangents the M1 Road along

Kakwale River. Thence South Easterly following the district boundary of Mzimba and Kasungu along Kakwale River up to the confluence of Kakwale and Msusu Rivers, thence South westerly along the Kasungu Mzimba District boundaries, thence Southerly along the same boundary up to a point where Traditional Authority boundaries of Chisemphe, Simlemba, thence South Westerly along the Traditional Authority Chisemphe and Simlemba boundary up to a point where Traditional Authority Chisemphe, Simlemba and Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja meet. Thence Westerly along the boundary of Traditional authority Chisemphe and Sub Traditional M'nyanja up to M1 Road. Thence South Westerly following the M1 Road up to the point where M1 Road crosses Mpasadzi River. Thence North Westerly along Mpasadzi River which is also boundary of Traditional Authority M'nyanja and Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa up to the converging point Traditional Authority Chulu, Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa and Traditional Authority M'nyanja, thence Northerly along Mpasadzi River, which is also the boundary between Traditional Authority Chulu and Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja through a point where boundaries for Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga, Traditional Authority Chulu and Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja, thence Northerly along the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga, Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja along Mpasadzi River up passing through point where boundaries for Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga, Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja and Traditional Authority Kaluluma meet, thence Northerly along Mpasadzi River along the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga and Traditional Authority Kaluluma up to the international boundary between Malawi and Zambia. Thence North Easterly following the international boundary up to a point where the international boundary coincides with Mzimba and Kasungu district boundary, thence Easterly along the district boundary up to the point of commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **LODJWA WARD AND NTHEMBWE WARD**

Lodjwa Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 28,947.

Nthembwe Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 17,521.

Lodjwa is to the North and Nthembwe is to the South of the Constituency.

Lodjwa Ward covers the whole jurisdiction of Traditional Authority Kaluluma and Sub Traditional Authority Chisikwa. Nthembwe Ward covers the whole area of Traditional Authority Chisemphere, and Western part of Traditional Authority M'nyanja.

The boundary starts at a point where boundaries of Traditional Authority Kaluluma and Traditional Authority Chisemphere, coincide with the Kasungu and Mzimba district boundary, thence Westerly, along the boundary of Traditional Authority Chisemphere and Traditional Authority Kaluluma thence Westerly along the boundary up to where boundaries for Traditional Authority Kalululuma, Chisemphere and Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja meet, thence South Westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kalululuma and Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja up to the where boundaries for Traditional Authority Kalululuma, Sub Traditional Authority Mnyanja and Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga converge, which is the constituency boundary.

## 1.2. **KASUNGU NORTH WEST**

*The constituency covers the whole jurisdiction of Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga, Traditional Authority Chulu and Sub Traditional Traditional Authority Mphomwa*

Kasungu North has a projected eligible voter population of 48,468.

The boundary commences at a point where boundary for Traditional Authority Kaluluma and Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga meets the International boundary which is at the source of Mpasadzi River, thence Southerly along Mpasadzi River which is also the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaluluma and Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga up to a point where, boundaries for Traditional Authority Kaluluma, Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja, Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga, proceeding Southerly along the boundary

of Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga and Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja up to a point where boundaries of Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga, Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja and Traditional Authority Chulu meet, thence Southerly along the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja and Traditional Authority Chulu, along Mpasadzi River up to a point where boundaries for Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa, Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja and Traditional Authority Chulu meet, thence Southerly along the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa and Sub Traditional Authority Mnyanja, along Mpasadzi River intersecting M1 Road thence South easterly up to point of convergencce of Traditional Authority boundaries for Kaomba, Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja and Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa at the confluence of Mpasadzi and Dwangwa Rivers, thence South Westerly along Dwangwa River, which forms the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa and Traditional Authority Kaomba intersecting M1 Road, thence South Westerly along the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa and Traditional Authority Mwase, through a point where boundaries for Traditional Authority Chulu, Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa and Traditional Authority Mwase meet, proceeding Westwards along the boundary of Traditional Authority Chulu and Traditional Authority Mwase, thence Westwards to a point where boundary of Traditional Authority Chulu and Traditional Authority Mwase coincide with the boundary of Kasungu National Park thence Westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Chulu and Kasungu National Park following Dwangwa river up to its confluence with Mchenda River, thence Northerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Chulu and Kasungu National Park up to where it coincide with boundary of Traditional Authority Chulu and Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga thence Northerly along the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga and Kasungu National Park, up to the International boundary of Malawi and Zambia, thence North Easterly along International boundary up to a point where it meets the boundary for Traditional Authority Kaluluma and Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga, which is the point of commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **MATENJE WARD AND MPASADZI WARD**

Matenje Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 25,948.

Mpasadzi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 22,520.

Matenje Ward is to the North and Mpasadzi Ward to the South of the Constituency.

Matenje covers the whole Area of Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga and Northern part of Traditional Authority Chulu. Mpasadzi ward covers the whole Area of Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa and Southern part of Traditional Authority Chulu.

The boundary for the two wards starts at the confluence of Juni and Mpasadzi Rivers at Manzi Trading Centre, Westerly along Juni River up to the confluence of Juni and Kasamba Rivers, thence South Westerly along Kasamba River up to the confluence with Mchenda River, thence Northerly along Mchenda River up to its confluence with unnamed Stream at coordinate 534004E, 8589128N, thence along the Stream North Westerly to Kasungu National Park boundary which is also the constituency boundaries at 533477E 8589578N.

### 1.3. **KASUNGU NORTH NORTH EAST**

*This constituency covers Traditional Authority Simlemba, part of Traditional Authority Wimbe and part of Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja*

Kasungu North North East has a projected eligible voter population of 50,098.

It starts at a point where Traditional authority boundaries of Chisemphe, Simlemba meets the Kasungu and Mzimba District boundary, thence, North easterly along the Kasungu Mzimba district boundary, thence South Easterly along the district boundary, thence North Easterly along Mtabua river, joining Milenje River then Luwerezi River, thence South Easterly along Luwerezi River up to its Confluence with Dwangwa River still along the district boundary up to the confluence of Luwerezi and Dwangwa Rivers. Thence Easterly

following Dwangwa River, up to its Confluence with Liwala River, which is also the point of convergence of Mzimba, Kasungu and Nkhotakota districts. Thence Southerly along Liwala River which is also the Nkhotakota and Kasungu district boundaries up to the point where the boundary Traditional Authority Wimbe and Traditional Authority Kapelula meet the Nkhotakota – Kasungu district boundary, thence South Westerly along the Traditional Authority Wimbe and Traditional Authority Kapelula boundary along Liwala River up to its confluence with unnamed stream at coordinate 588129E, 8582244N, thence North Westerly along the Stream, thence following an Earth road in the same direction, up to where it joins an unnamed River to coordinate 587475E, 8582492N, thence along the unnamed Stream Westerly through Joveni village up to where it where intersect T328, at Kambira School, thence Westerly following the Earth Road through Kambira, Chikaola village, crossing Kambira River, up to Livwezi River, thence Northerly along Livwezi River, thence South Westerly joining an Earth Road passing through Chikulima, Chimsasa, Kanyama villages, up to Chikowa School. Thence North Westerly along the Earth Road passing through Kaulanyengo School, up to Chimbiya Trading Centre, thence South Westerly along the Earth Road Liziri School up to where the Road intersects Chitete River which also the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Wimbe, thence North Easterly along Chitete River which forms the boundary between Traditional Authority Kaomba and Wimbe, up to the converging point of Traditional Authority boundaries of Wimbe, Simulemba and Kaomba, thence Westerly along Dwangwa River which forms the boundary of Traditional Authority Simlemba and Kaomba, then Sub Traditional Authority M’nyanja and Traditional Authority Kaomba up to the confluence of Mpasadzi and Dwangwa Rivers, which is also the converging point of Traditional Authority Kaomba, Sub Traditional Authority M’nyanja and Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa. Thence North Westerly along Mpasadzi River, which is the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority M’nyanja and Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa up to the point where the Mpasadzi River meets the M1 Road from Chinjewazi Trading Centre. Thence North Easterly along the M1 Road, through Chinjewazi Trading Centre up, then Chitunda School, up to the converging point of Traditional Authority Chisemphere and Sub Traditional Authority M’nyanja, thence North Easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Chisemphere and Sub Traditional Authority Mnyanja up to (the converging point of Traditional

Authority Chisemphere, Simlemba and Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanja), at Chatoloma Trading Centre thence North Easterly, along Traditional Authority Chisemphere and Simlemba boundary, to a point where it coincides with boundaries of Mzimba and Kasungu districts, up the point of commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **NTHABUWA WARD AND MPENI WARD**

Nthabuwa Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 24,516.

Mpeni Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 25,582.

Nthabuwa Ward is to the West and Mpeni Ward to the East of the constituency.

Nthabuwa Ward covers Eastern part of Traditional Authority Mnyanja and Western part of Traditional Authority Simlemba. Mpeni Ward covers Northern part of Traditional Authority Wimbe and the Northwestern part of Traditional Authority Simlemba to the South.

The boundary between the wards starts at Coordinate 568633E, 8594992N along the district boundary of Kasungu and Mzimba, thence Southerly along an Earth Road passing through Msekwanthu, up to the source of Munyamadzi River, thence Southerly along Munyamandzi River, up to its confluence with unnamed Stream to its source in Chikakula Village, thence Westerly along the Stream to its source, then joins an Earth Road through Themba Village, up to the point where the Earth Road intersect Kapululu River, thence South Easterly along Kapupulu River up to the confluence with Dwangwa river, thence South westerly along Dwangwa river up to its Confluence with Chitete River which is the Constituency boundary.

#### **1.4. KASUNGU NORTH EAST**

This constituency covers Eastern part of Traditional Authority Wimbe to the East and the whole jurisdiction area of Traditional Authority Kapelula, Sub Traditional Authority Mdunga and Sub Traditional Authority Kapichira.

Kasungu North East has a projected eligible voter population of 46,866.

The boundary commences at a point where the boundary of Traditional Authority Wimbe and Kapelula Meets the district boundary of Kasungu and Nkhotakota. Thence, South Easterly along the District boundary up to the confluence of Damba and Mphongwe Rivers, thence southerly along the district boundary up to the confluence of Bua and Damba Rivers, thence South Westerly along Bua River on the district boundary, up to the converging point of Ntchisi, Kasungu and Nkhotakota districts, thence South Westerly along Kasungu Ntchisi boundary, up to the confluence of Kasikidzi and Bua Rivers, where Traditional Authority Wimbe and Chilowamatambe meets the district boundary, thence North Westerly along Kasikidzi River which also forms Traditional Authority boundary of Wimbe and Chilowamatambe up to where Kasikidzi River intersects T332 Road, (which goes to Msiwa Trading Centre), thence Northerly following T332 Road through Msiwa Trading Centre up to Thumba River, thence North Westerly along Thumba River to its source, thence joining an earth Road up to T328 Road, at Nyambo village, thence North Easterly along T328 Road, up to the intersection of T328 Road, and a Road at Kapyanga Trading centre, thence Easterly along an Earth Road to a stream, thence easterly along the Stream through Joveni village, along the Stream then joining an Earth Road crossing the Road from Chipanthenga, up to a Stream that joins Liwala River, thence South Easterly along the stream to its confluence with Liwala River, thence Northerly along Liwala River which forms Traditional Authority boundary between Kapelula and Wimbe up to the point where the boundary of Traditional Authority Wimbe and Kapelula meets the district boundary of Kasungu and Nkhotakota, which is the point of commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **NDONDA WARD AND MBONGOZI WARD**

Ndonda Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 27,702.

Mbongozi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 19,164.

Ndonda is to the North and Mbongozi to the South of the constituency.

Ndonda comprises of the following, the North Eastern part of Traditional Authority Wimbe, Northern part of Traditional Authority Kapelula and the whole of Sub Traditional Authority Kapichila. Mbongozi comprises of South Eastern part of Traditional Authority Wimbe, the whole of Sub Traditional Authority Mdunga and the Southern part of Kapelula

The boundary commences at Chimbowe CDSS, at the point where an Earth road intersects T328 Road, thence easterly following the earth Road through Chamama Area, thence joining Kafota River up to its source, then joining T329 Road, thence Easterly following T329 Road, passing through Chamama Trading Centre up to the point where it intersects T332 from Ndaki village thence South easterly along the Chinthimbiri River up to its confluence with Titimila River, thence South Easterly along Chinthimbiri River up to its confluence with Bua River along the district boundary which is the Constituency boundary

#### 1.5. **KASUNGU EAST**

Kasungu East has a projected eligible voter population of 49,834.

The constituency starts at an intersection of T328 Road, and a Road from Joven at Kapyanga Trading centre, thence Southerly along T328 Road passing through Mbira village, Mkanganya school up to an intersection with an Earth Road at Nyambo village. Thence Southerly up to the source of Thumba River 582719E, 8565749N, thence Southerly following Thumba River up to its intersection with T332 Road, thence South Westerly along T322 Road to Kasikidzi, passing through Msiwa Trading Centre up to the point where T322 Road intersects Kasikidzi River, where the boundaries of Traditional

Authority Wimbe and Chilowamatabe meet. Thence Westerly along the Traditional Authority Boundary up to the point where T325 Road intersects M18 Road, thence North Westerly along the Traditional Authority boundary up to the point where the Traditional Authority boundaries of Traditional Authority Wimbe, Chilowamatabe and Kaomba converge, thence North westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Wimbe up to the confluence of Nthema and Chitete Rivers, thence North Easterly along Chitete River which is the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Wimbe up to its confluence with Kawilawila River, thence North Easterly following an Earth Road passing through Liziri School joining T325 Road at Chimbiya Trading centre, thence South Easterly along T325 Road, up to Chikowa School, thence North Easterly following an Earth Road through Thunga, Chimsasa, Chikulima, Tambila villages, up to the intersection with T328 Road which is the point of Commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **KACHOKOLO WARD AND LIVWEZI WARD**

Kachokolo Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 28,543.

Livwezi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 21,291. Kachokolo is to the West and Livwezi is to the east of the Constituency.

Livwezi ward comprises of the Western part of Traditional Authority Wimbe. Kachokolo Ward comprises of the Eastern part of Traditional Authority Wimbe.

The boundary for the two wards commences at a point where Livwezi River intersects the Earth Road from Chikulima village. Thence Southerly following Livwezi River up to its source at T328 Road (567810E, 8558654N), thence Easterly along the Earth Road up to a Stream that flows into Kasikidzi River, thence Southerly following the Stream to its confluence with Kasikidzi River, which is the Constituency boundary.568374E 8558644N

## 1.6. **KASUNGU CENTRAL WEST**

*The constituency covers the whole of Traditional Authority Kaomba, Kaphaizi, Mwase, Sub Traditional Authority Mangwazu and Sub Traditional Authority Mawawa*

Kasungu Central West has a projected eligible voter population of 48,440.

The boundary commences at the point where boundaries of Sub Traditional Authority Mphoma, Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanga and Traditional Authority Kaomba converge, at the confluence of Mpasadzi and Dwangwa Rivers. Thence Easterly, along Traditional Authority Kaomba and Sub Traditional Authority M'nyanya to the point where boundaries of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Traditional Authority Simlemba and Sub M'nyanja Traditional Authority M'nyanga converge. Thence Easterly along the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Simlemba and Traditional Authority Kaomba up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authority Simlemba, Traditional Authority Kaomba and Traditional Authority Wimbe converge which is the confluence of Chitete and Dwangwa Rivers. Thence South Westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Traditional Authority Wimbe up to the converging point of boundaries for Traditional Authority Kaomba, Traditional Authority Chilowamatambe and Traditional Authority Wimbe, thence South Westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Traditional Authority Chilowamatambe up to M18 Road. Thence North Westerly along M18 Road up to the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Kasungu Municipality, thence Northerly following the municipality boundary up to Chitete river, thence westerly up to M1 Road, thence Southerly along the Kasungu Municipality boundary, Traditional Authority Lukwa and Traditional Authority Mwase, thence South Westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Mwase and Traditional Authority Lukwa, up to the converging point of Traditional Authority boundaries of Lukwa, Mwase and Sub Traditional Authority Mawawa, thence South Westerly along the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Mawawa and Traditional Authority Lukwa up to Kalindi River. Thence North westerly along the Traditional Authority boundary up to the converging point of boundaries for Kasungu National Park, Sub Traditional Authority

Mawawa and Traditional Authority Lukwa, which is also at the confluence of Kalindi and Lisitu Rivers, thence Northerly, along the boundary of Kasungu National Park and Sub Traditional Authority Mawawa proceeding with the boundary between Kasungu National Park and Sub Traditional Authority Mangwazu the Kasungu National Park and Traditional Authority Kaphaizi, then the National Park and Traditional Authority Mwase up to Dwangwa River, thence Easterly along Dwanga River which is the boundary between Traditional Authority Mwase and Traditional Authority Chulu, thence proceeding with Traditional Authority Mwase and Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa crossing the M1 Road, to the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Mphomwa and Kaomba up to the point of Commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **LINGADZI WARD AND CHIPALA WARD**

Lingadzi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 27,413.

Chipala Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 21,027. Lingadzi is to the west and Chipala is to the East of the constituency.

Lingadzi Ward covers areas of Sub Traditional Authority Mawawa, Sub Traditional Authority Mangwazu.

Chipala Ward covers covers eastern part of Mwase and Northern part of Kaomba areas the whole of Traditional Authority Kaphaizi and the Western part of Traditional Authority Mwase.

The boundary between the two wards commences at the point where M1 Road intersects Dwangwa River, thence South Easterly along M1 Road up to Dwangwa School, thence Westerly along an Earth Road up to Kagumukire River, thence Southerly along Kagumukira River up to its intersection with an Earth Road through Kacheche village,

thence South Easterly along the Earth Road, up to the point where it meets T323 Road, thence Easterly along T323 up to the Municipality boundary, which is the constituency boundary.

#### 1.7. **KASUNGU SOUTH EAST**

*The constituency covers the whole area of Traditional Authority Chilowamatambe, Sub Traditional Authority Chambwe, South Eastern part of Traditional Authority Kaomba and North Eastern part of Traditional Authority Njombwa.*

Kasungu South East has a projected eligible voter population of 52,025.

The boundary starts at a point where boundaries of Traditional Authority Wimbe, Chilowamatambe, and Kaomba converge. Thence South Easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Wimbe and Chilowamatambe up to Chitenje School, thence North Easterly along the same Traditional Authority boundary up to Bua River, which forms the boundary of Kasungu and Ntchisi districts, thence South westerly along the Bua River up to the Nkalalo and Bua Rivers confluence which is also the converging point of Ntchisi, Kasungu, and Dowa district boundaries , thence South westerly along the Dowa Kasungu district boundary up to the point of intersection of Bua River and M1 Road. Thence Northerly along the M1 Road up to the Kasungu Municipality boundary, thence North easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Kasungu Municipality boundary with Traditional Authority Kaomba up to M18 Road, thence South Easterly along M18 Road up to the point where M18 Road intersects the boundary of Traditional Authority Chilowamatambe and Traditional Authority Kaomba, thence North Easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kaomba and Chilowamatambe up to the point of commencement.

#### **WARDS**

#### **MZIZA WARD AND CHIBOPHI WARD**

Chibophi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 31,802.

Mziza Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 20,223.

Mziza ward is to the West and Chibophi ward to the East.

Mziza ward comprises of the Eastern part of Traditional Authority Njombwa, South eastern part of Traditional Authority Kaomba and the whole area of Sub Traditional Authority Chambwe. Chibophi ward, comprises of the whole area of Traditional Authority Chilowamatambe .

The boundary the separates the two wards starts at the junction of M18 and T325 Roads in Dudu village. Thence Westerly along M18 Road up to its junction with an Earth Road at coordinate 562028E, 8553335N. thence Southerly through Nkhakomisesa village through Chikaola village up to its junction with an Earth road from Mawango (Kapiri) school, thence South Easterly along the road up to Jossam village where the road intersects a Stream from Nyanyu village, thence Southerly along the Stream up to Chinguwo School/Nthumbidwa Trading Centre, proceeding with the Stream South easterly through Chitsulo, Zinthonga, Chikho villages up to Bua River which is the Constituency boundary.

#### 1.8. **KASUNGU WEST**

*The constituency covers the whole of Traditional Authority Lukwa, Western part of Traditional Authority Njombwa, Northern part of Traditional Authority Kawamba, Kasungu National Park, and the South Western Part of Traditional Authority Kaomba*

Kasungu West has a projected eligible voter population of 53,780.

The boundary commences at the converging point of convergence for the Malawi – Zambia international boundary, Kasungu National Park and Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga.

Thence Southerly along the boundary between Kasungu National Park and Sub Traditional Authority Chisinga, then National Park and Traditional Authority Chulu, thence Easterly along national Park and Traditional Authority Chulu up to the convergence point of the National Park, Traditional Authority Chulu and Traditional Authority Mwase, thence Southerly along the National park and Traditional Authority Mwase boundary, then proceeding with the boundary between the National park and Kaphaizi, up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authority Kaphaizi, Sub Traditional Authority Mangwazu and National Park converge, thence South Westerly along the boundary of National Park and Sub Traditional Authority Mangwazu, thence Southerly along National Park and Mangwazu up to the point of convergence for National Park, Sub Traditional Authority Mawawa and Traditional Authority Lukwa boundaries thence South Easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Lukwa and Sub Traditional Authority Mawawa, thence North Easterly along the same boundary, the proceeding to the boundary between Traditional Authority Lukwa and Traditional Authority Mwase up to the point where boundaries of Traditional Authority Mwase, Traditional Authority Lukwa and Kasungu Municipality converge, thence Easterly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Lukwa and Kasungu Municipality, then proceeding to the boundary between Kasungu Municipality and Traditional Authority Kaomba through on M1 Road to the boundary between Traditional Authority Kaomba and Traditional Authority Njombwa formed by M1 Road, thence Southerly up to its intersection with Bua River, which is the district boundary between Dowa and Kasungu, thence Westerly up to the confluence of Rusa and Bua Rivers, where Traditional Authority Kawamba and Traditional Authority Chidzuma meet the district boundary between Dowa and Kasungu, thence North westerly following Rusa River which forms boundary between Traditional Authority Kawamba and Traditional Authority Chidzuma up to the confluence of Rusa and Lisandwa Rivers thence North Westerly along Lisandwa River through Lisandwa School, Kaluluma CDSS, Zumani School, up to the National Park, thence South Westerly along the boundary between National Park and Traditional Authority Kawamba proceeding with the boundary between National Park and Sub Traditional Authority Nthunduwala up to the International boundary between Malawi and Zambia, thence Northerly along the International boundary up to the point of commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **LIFUPA WARD AND CHIDZENJE WARD**

Lifupa Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 28,819.

Chidzenje Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 24,961.

Lifupa is to the North and Chidzenje to the Southern part of the Constituency.

Lifupa Ward covers the whole area of Traditional Authority Lukwa, Kasungu National Park and South Western part of Traditional Authority Kaomba. Chidzenje Ward covers North Eastern part of Traditional Authority Kawamba, Western part of Njombwa.

The boundary that separates the two wards starts from the M1 Road at a point where the boundary of Traditional Authority Njombwa and Traditional Authority Kaomba meets M1 Road at coordinate 554194E, 8540547N, thence North westerly along Traditional Authority Kaomba and Njombwa up to the point of intersection with S117 Road , thence South Westerly proceeding with the boundary between Traditional Authority Lukwa and Traditional Authority Njombwa, thence Westerly along the boundary of Traditional Authority Kawamba and Lukwa up to the National Park, thence Southerly along the boundary between the National Park and Traditional Authority Kawamba up to the constituency boundary.

#### **1.9. KASUNGU SOUTH WEST**

*The Constituency covers the whole of area of Sub Traditional Authority Nthunduwala, Southern part of Traditional Authority Kawamba, the Western Part of Chidzuma. And Sub Traditional Authority Chaima*

Kasungu Southwest has a projected eligible voter population of 43,760.

The boundary commences at a point of confluence between Lisitu river and a Stream at coordinate 525098E, 8543043N along the boundary of Kasungu National Park and Traditional Authority Kawamba, thence South Easterly following the Stream up to its source thence South easterly joining Lisandwa River to its confluence with Rusa River which is the boundary between Traditional Authority Chidzuma and Traditional Authority Kawamba, formed by Rusa River thence Westerly along the same boundary up to the point of intersection with a road from Chomola Trading Centre, thence Southerly along the Road, then joining the River that passes through Chafisi Estate, thence South westerly along an Earth Road up to M18 at Chaima Trading Centre, thence South Westerly to the district boundary with Mchinji, thence North westerly along the district boundary thence Westerly along the same boundary to the International Boundary between Malawi and Zambia, thence Northerly along the International boundary up to the point where the International boundary converge with the boundary between the National Park and Sub Traditional Authority Nthunduwala, 492258E 8524137N thence North Easterly along the boundary of the National Park and Sub Traditional Authority Nthunduwala then proceeding with the boundary of National Park and Traditional Authority Kawamba up to the point of commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **LISANDWA WARD AND MISOZI WARD**

Lisandwa Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 24,510.

Misozi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 19, 250.

Lisandwa is to the North and Misozi to the Southern part of the constituency.

Lisandwa covers the Southern part of Traditional Authority Kawamba and the whole area of Sub Traditional Authority Nthunduwala. Misozi ward covers Sub Traditional Authority Chaima and the Western part of Traditional Authority Chidzuma.

The boundary starts at a point with coordinate 538163E, 8524243N, at the confluence of Rusa River and a Stream, thence North Westerly along boundary of Traditional Authority Kawamba and Traditional Authority Chidzuma formed by Rusa River up to the point where boundaries of Traditional Authority Chidzuma, Traditional Authority Kawamba and Sub Traditional Authority Chaima converge, thence South Westerly along Rusa River which is the boundary of Sub Traditional Authority Nthunduwala and Sub Traditional Authority Chaima up to the confluence of Rusa River and Mavumbi River along the district boundary which marks the constituency boundary. The ward boundary is Rusa River

#### 1.10. **KASUNGU SOUTH**

*The Constituency covers the whole jurisdiction of Traditional Authority Santhe and the eastern part of Traditional Authority Chidzuma.*

Kasungu South has a projected eligible voter population of 45,154.

The boundary starts from the point where M18 Road intersects Rusa River. Thence Easterly along Rusa River, which forms the boundary between Traditional Authority Kawamba and Chidzuma up to the confluence of Bua and Rusa Rivers, thence Southerly along the district boundary between Dowa and Kasungu formed by Bua River up to the point where the boundaries of Dowa, Lilongwe and Kasungu converge at the confluence of Nambuma and Bua Rivers, thence Southerly along Kasungu and Lilongwe boundary up to the point where boundaries of Mchinji, Lilongwe and Kasungu converge thence North Westerly along Mutongozi River up to M18 Road thence North easterly up along M18 road to Chaima trading Centre, thence North Easterly along an earth road through Chafisi Estate joining a Stream, thence North easterly along the Stream joining an Earth Road which intersects Rusa River at Katema Village, thence Easterly along Traditional Authority

Kawamba and Traditional Authority Chidzuma formed by Rusa River up to the point intersection with M18 Road which is the point of commencement.

## **WARDS**

### **CHIGODI WARD AND CHIYANJAWENI WARD**

Chigodi Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 26, 728.

Chiyanjaweni Ward has a projected eligible voter population of 18, 426.

Chigodi Ward is to the North Eastern part while Chiyanjaweni is the Southern part of the Constituency.

The boundary commences at Chaima Trading Centre along M18 Road, thence South Easterly following an Earth Road passing through Mthunzi and Nyakhwanya Villages, Bindu Estate, up to a stream in Mangazi village, thence South Easterly through Kantimbo up to its confluence with Bua River along Lilongwe and Kasungu district boundary, which is also the constituency boundary.
