REVIEW OF CONSTITUENCY AND WARD BOUNDARIES

PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF CONSTITUENCY AND WARD
BOUNDARIES
MZIMBA

Pursuant to its powers under the Constitution of the Republic of Malawi and the Electoral Commission Act, the Commission has determined that the boundaries of the constituencies and wards in Mzimba District Council for the purposes of the 2025 Parliamentary and Local Government Elections shall be as follows:

1. CONSTITUENCIES

1.1. MZIMBA SOUTH EAST

The Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 40,257

The boundary of the constituency commences at the boundary of Traditional Authority Mzikubola and Traditional Authority Gwaza Jere at the point where there is a district boundary between Mzimba and Nkhotakota districts. It then follows the district boundary with Nkhotakota running South Easterly and then South Westerly to the meeting point of Mzimba, Nkhotakota and Kasungu Districts. Thence follows Mzimba and Kasungu districts boundary Westerly to the confluence of Luwerezi and Milenje Rivers. It follows Luwerezi River North Westerly up to the confluence of Msusu River and Luwerezi and it follows a Stream Northerly to coordinate 569494E, 8610510N. Then it follows a galley North Easterly and takes a footpath Easterly and North Easterly to take the road near Tigawanenge School and turns Northwards on another road to Polombwe Mweka Village. Then takes a road North Easterly crossing Luwerezi River to Jeketera F.P. School. Thence it takes a road towards Mwantche L.E.A School and takes a Northward turn 140 metres before Mwantche L.E.A. School that goes North Easterly to Chikumula F.P. School and continues with the same road Northerly to coordinate 579369E, 8619596N. Thence takes a footpath South Westerly crossing Mkunthu River to the Traditional Boundary between Traditional Authorities Mabulabo and Khonsolo Gwaza Jere at coordinate 577730E, 8618069N. It follows the Traditional Boundary North Westerly and follows Mkumbanjara river at coordinate 576319E, 8619372N up to Chivina Mwaya Village. Thence joins Secondary Road S113 North Westerly and follows path road off S113 road to Kawiwale F.P. School Northerly to Luwerezi River and follows it Easterly up to coordinate 576661E,8625153N Easterly crossing District Road D167 into Rukuru at coordinate 579448E, 8626439N then takes Rukuru River Northerly to coordinate 577523E, 8629266N. Then follows a stream North Easterly then a footpath Northerly into Rukuru

River again. Thence follows Rukuru River to coordinates 578711E, 8630912 then follows a road Northerly and turns Westerly at coordinate 578329E, 8631943N. Then turns Westerly up to D167 Road and follows the said road North Easterly into a stream which flows to Rupashe River then follows the said river Westerly and Northerly the meeting point of Traditional Authorities Mabulabo, Mzikubola and Khonsolo Gwaza Jere, then follows boundary between Traditional Authorities Mzikubola and Khonsolo Gwaza Jere Northerly and easterly to the commencement point , being meeting point of Mzimba and Nkhotakota districts as well as Traditional Authorities Mzikubola and Khonsolo Gwaza Jere.

KHONSOLO SOUTH WARD AND KHONSOLO NORTH WARD

(i) Khonsolo South Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 22, 040

(ii) Khonsolo North Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 18, 217

The boundary between the two wards commences on the road between Jeketera F.P. School and Mwantche LEA School going to Chitunda School through Muthanji Banda Village soon after crossing Liziwazi River (170 metres from the river) running South Easterly then

crosses a stream up to coordinate 574944E, 8611316. Then follows a road to Phwazi River (which is to the North of Chitunda F.P. School), finishing at the district boundary which is also a constituency boundary.

1.2. **MZIMBA LUWEREZI**

The Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 44,153

The boundary commences at meeting point of traditional Authorities Mzikubola, Khonsolo Gwaza Jere and Mabulabo, then follows boundary between traditional Authorities Mabulabo and Khonsolo Gwaza Jere Southerly. Then Easterly to coordinate 581888E, 8636309N then connects to a stream South Westerly then connects D167 Road at coordinate 577209E, 8632039N Easterly to coordinate 578329E, 8631943N then it follows the road Southerly to coordinates 578711E, 8630912N. Then it follows Rukuru River South Westerly to coordinate 577980E, 8630457N then follows a footpath Southerly and a stream South Westerly to Rukuru River at coordinate 577523E, 8629266N. Then it continues to follow Rukuru River Southerly to coordinate 579448E, 8626439N. Then it follows a stream Westerly and crosses D167 Road to Luwerezi River at coordinate 576661E, 8625153N. Then it follows Luwerezi River Westerly to coordinate 575037E, 8624759N then Southerly following the road past Kaviwale F.P. School into secondary road S113 South Easterly to Chivina Mwaya village then Southerly to Mkumbanjara River. It then follows Traditional boundary between Khonsolo Gwaza Jere and Mabulabo at coordinate 577730E, 8618069N then follows a footpath North Easterly to coordinate

579369E, 8619596N. Thence follows the road Southerly passing Chikumula F.P. School then continue with the road South Westerly to the North of Mwantche L.E.A School. Then turns South to a point which is 140 metres from Mwantche L.E.A School then follows a road Westerly crossing Liziwazi River to Jeketera F.P. School. From there is follows District Road D70 Northerly then follows another road Westerly to Polombwe Mweka village. Then it follows a road Southerly and turn on the Western side of Tigawanenge School going South Westerly following a galley South Westerly to coordinate 569494E, 8610510N then follows a stream Southerly that flows into Msusu River. Then it follows Msusu River to Luwerezi River and follows Luwerezi River South Easterly to the confluence of Milenje River and Luwerezi River. Then it follows the district boundary between Mzimba, and Kasungu to the international boundary between Zambia and Malawi North easterly and Northerly to a point of the Traditional boundary between Mzikubola and Mabulabo along the international boundary. Then Esterly following the Traditional Authorities boundary to the commencement point where Traditional Authorities Mzikubola, Mabulabo and Khonsolo Gwaza Jere.

MABULABO SOUTH WARD AND MABULABO NORTH WARD

(i) Mabilabo South Ward

The ward has projected eligible voter population of 19, 548

(ii) Mabilabo North Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 24, 605

The boundary between the two wards commences at the intersection of the secondary road S113 and Kakware River on the District Boundary of Kasungu and Mzimba going Easterly to Luwerezi River, thence following Luwerezi River Southerly and turn at coordinate 569496E, 8615918N to follow a road South Westerly that connects Chivukutu F.P. School and Endhlaleni J.P. School. Then follows a road South Easterly to Pholombwe Mweka village which is the constituency boundary.

1.3. **MZIMBA SOUTH WEST**

The Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 40,013.

The boundary for the constituency commences at a point where the footpath that crossed the Kaonekera- Madede- Mbalachanda Road (from the West) meets South Rukuru River. Then it follows South Rukuru River Southerly to the Traditional Authority boundary between Traditional Authorities Mzikubola and M'Mbelwa thence Southwards up to the international boundary with Zambia. Then westwards following the international boundary with Zambia. Thence turn northerly following the same international boundary to the coordinate 534356E, 8703426N) on the Zambia-Malawi international boundary. Then

follows the footpath that crosses the Kaonekera-Madede- Mbalachanda Road to the South Rukuru being the commencement point.

ENGALAWENI WARD AND KAPOPO WARD

(i) Engalaweni Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 16,574

(ii) Kapopa Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 23,439

The boundary between the two wards commences at the point where the source of Belele River meets the Malawi Zambia international boundary at coordinate 531355E, 8654108N and follows Belele River North and North easterly to point where Belele River meets or flows into South Rukuru River.

1.4. MZIMBA SOUTH CONSTITUENCY

The Constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 47, 273

The boundary for Mzimba South Constituency commences at Thoza Turnoff on the M1 Road following the M1 Road southerly passing through Luviri Trading Centre and Champhira Turnoff all the way to Jenda Trading Centre. Then follow the Malawi-Zambia international boundary Westerly to the point on the international boundary where Traditional Authorities M'Mbelwa and Mzikubola meet. Thence following the said traditional authorities boundary Northerly to South Rukuru River. Thence follows South

Rukuru River (boundary of T/A M'mbelwa and T/A Mzukuzuku) to the confluence of South Rukuru River and Lwasozi River then takes Lwasozi River Easterly to Thoza Road (M20) (543634E. 8658716N)) to the Commencement point at the Thoza Turnoff on the M1Road.

MABIRI WARD AND LUVIRI WARD

(i) Mabiri ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 18,664

(ii) Luviri Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 28, 609

The boundary between the two wards commences at the point of the boundary of Traditional Authorities Mzukuzuku, Mzukubola and M'Mbelwa Northwards following Traditional Authority boundary between Mzukuzuku and Mzikubola up to the constituency boundary, being Thoza RoadM20.

1.5. MZIMBA PEREKEZI CONSTITUENCY

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 43, 129

The boundary for the constituency commences at the confluence of Mzimba River and Matibula River, South Easterly following Mzimba River and turns at coordinate 564432E, 8689050N Easterly along the stream that flows from Traditional boundary between Traditional Authorities M'Mbelwa and Kampingo Sibande. Then Southerly to the meeting point of Traditional Authorities M'Mbelwa and Kampingo Sibande and Mzimba Boma, then it follows the Westerly Mzimba boma and Traditional Authority M'Mbelwa boundary to Mzimba River then follows Mzimba River Southerly to Mzimba Bridge on the road to St. Pauls and continue following Mzimba River to Tete River and South following Mzimba Boma boundary to Mzimba River and follows it South Easterly to its mouth at coordinate 575690E, 8675227N then follows a footpath South and Easterly then follows Thanthe River at coordinate 576701E, 8674648N. It continues following Thanthe River to Perekezi Forest Reserve then follows the boundary of Pelekezi Forest Reserve Northerly and South Easterly to the boundary of Pelekezi and Luwawa Forest Reserves Southerly to coordinate 577879E, 8664662N. then follows a footpath Southerly to coordinate 577869E, 8664190N then it follows a footpath South Easterly running parallel to Ruskeke River up to the Eastern side of a dam and then follows another road Easterly that runs parallel to Luwawa River to District boundary with Nkhotakota at coordinate 585332E, 8662878N. Then it follows district boundary Southerly up to the point where Traditional Authorities Khonsolo Gwaza Jere and Mzikubola meet at the District boundary, then it follows the said Traditional Authority boundaries Westerly then Southerly to the point where Traditional Authorities Mzikubola, Khonsolo Gwaza Jere and Mabilabo meet. Then it follows Traditional Authority boundary between Mzikubola and Mabilabo along D74 road Westerly to M1 Road Northerly to Thoza Turnoff on the M1 Road follows Thoza Road

M20 and turns at coordinate 563769E, 8663938 Northwards to a stream which flows Northeasterly to Kavukura River to Mharaunda River Westerly to coordinate 555727E, 8668811N. then it follows the road Northerly crossing a stream and follows traditional Authority boundary between Mzikubola and M'Mbelwa North Easterly then boundary between Traditional Authority M'Mbelwa and Mzimba Boma boundary to Mnjiri Bridge then follows M9 Road Westerly then turns at Kaulira to Chakazi bridge and follows Mzimba River Easterly to the commencement point at the confluence of Mzimba and Matibula Rivers.

HOHO WARD AND BOMA WARD

(i) Hoho Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 16, 700

(ii) Boma Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 26, 429

The boundary between the two wards commences at Western tip of Pelekezi Forest at coordinate 556539E, 8672955 thence follows the Pelekezi Forest Reserve Easterly to M1Road and follows M1 Road North Easterly to Machecheta F.P.

School and follows a footpath to Mzimba River Bridge at coordinate 572689E, 8676145N which is also a constituency boundary.

1.6. **MZIMBA SOLOLA CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 44, 166

The boundary for the constituency commences at Chakazi Bridge Southerly to Kaulira then Easterly following M9 Road to Mnjiri Bridge and Southerly following boundary between Mzimba Boma and Traditional Authority M'Mbelwa. Then it follows boundary between Traditional Authorities M'Mbelwa and Mzikubola South Westerly to a stream at coordinate 556539E, 8672955 then it follows a road Southerly to Mharaunda River. The it follows Mharaunda River Easterly then it follows Kavukura River South Easterly then it follows a stream to coordinate 563769E, 8663938N. Then it follows M20 Road Westerly to coordinate 543634E, 8658716N then it follows a footpath South Westerly to Lwasozi River which flows into South Rukuru River then it follows South Rukuru River Northerly to the confluence of Mzimba River and South Rukuru River then it follows Mzimba River Easterly to the commencement point, i.e., Chakazi River

EMTHUZINI WARD AND MANYAMULA WARD

(i) **Emthuzini Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 17, 693

(ii) **Manyamula Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 26, 473

The boundary that divides the two wards commence at the confluence of South Rukuru River and Milala River and follows Milala River Easterly to constituency boundary that is also the boundary between Traditional Authorities M'Mbelwa and Mzikubola.

1.7. **MZIMBA EAST CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 47, 462

The boundary for the constituency commences at a confluence between a stream North of Kajiti River and Lusangazi River at coordinate 603432E, 8731619. It then follows Lusangazi River Southerly along the District boundary with Nkhatabay District at coordinate 585332E, 8662878N. Then it follows the road Westerly, which parallel to Luwawa River then it turns Northerly following a road that runs parallel to Ruskeke River to coordinate 577869E, 8664190N. Then it follows a road Northerly to boundary of Perekezi and Luwawa Forest Reserves and continue following that boundary up to coordinate 582355E, 8675234N and turns Westerly and then Southerly following Perekezi Forest boundary to Thanthe River. It continues following Thanthe River Westerly to coordinate 576701E, 8674648N, then it follows a footpath Westerly then Northerly to the

mouth of Mzimba River at coordinate 575690E, 8675227N. Then it follows Mzimba River North Westerly up the confluence of Mzimba and Matibula Rivers and it follows Matibula River North Easterly and follows a stream Northerly which is a Traditional boundary between Traditional Authorities Chindi and Kampingo Sibande then it follows boundary between Traditional Authorities Mtwalo and Chindi along S107 and follows a road Northerly between Emoneni F.P. School but follows Kanyawayi River before Kanyawayi F.P. School. Kanyawayi river joins Kasitu River up to the confluence of Kasitu and Chipandu Rivers thence following the Traditional Authority boundary between Traditional Authorities Mtwalo and Kampingo Sibande to coordinate 593874E, 8732586N. Thence South Easterly to a road at coordinate 594166E, 8732464N at Enyezini F.P. School. Then it follows a road Easterly to Matuli River at coordinate 598652E, 8732244N. It then follows Matuli River South Westerly to coordinate 597399E, 8730643N. Then it follows a stream South Westerly to a North of Matuli School at coordinate 598194E, 8729730N. Then it follows a stream Easterly to coordinate 598822E, 8729924N. to a stream which flows to Kajiti river to coordinate 602300E, 8730040. Thence Northerly to a stream Easterly at coordinate 602043E, 8731249N which flows to Lusangazi River, which is the point of commencement.

KAMPINGO CENTRAL WARD

(i) **Kampingo Central Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 23, 697

(ii) Walula Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 23, 765

The boundary demarcating the two wards commences at point where Matibula ceases to be used as a Traditional Authority Boundary between Traditional Authorities Chindi and Kampingo Sibande, then it follows Matibula River Easterly to a stream which flows into Matibula River at coordinate 569331E, 8698513N. Then follows the stream Easterly to coordinate 572135E, 8698308N. Then turns Southerly following a footpath at the edge of hill turning Easterly to coordinate 575313E, 8699262N. Thence South Easterly along secondary S107 to coordinate 576033E, 8697885N. Then follows a footpath North Easterly to Gomezga F.P. School then it follows a road North of Mgomezga F.P. School to a stream which flows to Kasitu River Northerly to coordinate 576686E, 8701537N then follows a straight-line Easterly to a road along the Makutupi hills Easterly to the constituency boundary at the Eastern side of South Viphya Forest Reserve at coordinate 582021E, 8701889.

1.8. MZIMBA HORA

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 40, 658

The boundary for the constituency commences at the junction of secondary roads S106 and S107. Then it follows S107 Road Southerly, then follows Traditional boundary between

Traditional Authorities Chindi and Kapingo Sibande, i.e., Matibula River and follows Matibula River to where TA boundaries of M, MMBelwa Chindi and Kapingo Sibande meet. Then it follows Mzimba River up to its confluence with South Rukuru River, then Northerly along the South Rukuru River to coordinate 536221E, 8716797N; Thence Easterly crossing Matandani River along Mbalachanda Road to M9, then follows M9 Northerly to coordinate 544646E, 8722822N. Then follows the road Easterly crossing road D58 to coordinate 548536E, 8722424N then it follows a galley Northerly to Luweya River and follows Luweya River Easterly up to coordinate 553155E, 8723312N. Then it follows a stream Easterly to a road at coordinate 555532E, 8723538N then it follows a road North Easterly which is to the south of Nthumba Admarc which connects to a road from Nthengwe F.P. School to Nthumba F.P. School and follows that road South Easterly which is to the North of Nthumba F.P. School, then North Easterly to coordinate 558781E, 8724423. Then it follows a footpath to a stream and into another road at coordinate 560084E, 8723171N. Then it follows a road North Easterly joining T312 then to secondary road S106 and follows that road Easterly to the commencement point which is the junction between S106 and S107.

BULALA WARD AND MZALANGWE WARD

(i) Bulala Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 21, 324

(ii) **Mzalangwe Ward:**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 19,334

The boundary between the two wards commences at confluence of Mzimba and Kalira Rivers, then it follows the road North Westerly of Lwanjazi F.P. School crossing Wanyani River into a road North Easterly which connects Chasisi and Malinyete F.P. Schools and follows a tertiary Road T313 to a stream North Easterly before Tonthowere F.P. School and it follows that stream northerly to Lwankhozi River to coordinate 553909E, 8716100N. Then it follows a footpath South westerly passing through Ching'anyi School to a road at coordinate 552162E, 8716718N. Then Southerly following a road to District Road D58 and follows that road Northerly before St Marys School at coordinate 551337E, 8717645N then it follows that road Westerly crossing a stream to another stream which flows to Kapembere River at coordinate 546162E, 8718995N then it follows Kapembere River Northerly to a bridge where Kapembere River crosses M9 Road which is a constituency boundary.

1.9. **MZIMBA CENTRAL**

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population: 44, 305

The boundary for the constituency commences at the bridge on M9 Road on Kapando River, following M9 South Westerly to Kapando Trading Centre then follows the road South Easterly through Kapando F.P. School back to M9 Road up to Kavuwo River and

follows Kavuwu River Easterly to a road at coordinate 551132E, 8739031N. Then follows the road Southerly to coordinate 551337E, 8738607N then follows a footpath North Easterly to coordinate 551410E, 8738688N then follows a straight line South Easterly to a stream at coordinate 552013E, 8737598N, then it continues to follow the stream South Westerly to coordinate 550774E, 8737002N then it follows a footpath Southerly to Mzambazi River at coordinate 550392E, 8736241N then follows Mzambazi River South Easterly up to the bridge at Mzambazi River at coordinate 553985E, 8734772N then follows a road South Westerly to secondary road S106 at coordinate 553082E, 8732715N . Thence it follows same S106 Road South Easterly to coordinate 555660E, 8730274N South Westerly into a stream to coordinate 554094E, 8728862N then it follows a footpath North Westerly to a road at coordinate 553639E, 8729010N then it follows that road South Westerly to the North of Kamubanga School to Kamubanga River at coordinate 551875E, 8727923N then follows Kamubanga River up to its mouth at coordinate 558467E, 8724920N and follow the footpath Southerly to coordinate 558388E, 8724228N following the road that connects Nthumba F.P.School and Nthengwe F.P. School South and North Westerly turning at Nthumba Admarc South Westerly to a stream at coordinate 555532E, 8723538N then it follows that stream Westerly which flows into Luweya River following the said river Westerly to coordinate 548901E, 8723558N then it follows a galley Southerly to a road which connects to M9 then it follows M9 Southerly crossing Kapembere River turning south westerly into Mbalachanda Road to South Rukuru River at coordinate 536221E, 8716797N then Southerly following South Rukuru River to coordinate 537533E, 8703764N then it follows a footpath Westerly crossing Mbalachanda Road to coordinate 534357E, 8703427N at the international boundary (Malawi and Zambia) , then it follows

the said international boundary Northerly to meeting point of Traditional Authorities Chindi and Mpherembe on the international boundary then easterly following the Traditional Authorities boundary to the point of commencement at the bridge on M9 Road on Kapando River.

MBALACHANDA WARD AND EUTHINI WARD

(i) Mbalachanda Ward

Mbalachanda is to the west of the constituency while Euthini is to the east.

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 20, 858

(ii) Euthini Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 23, 447

The boundary between the two wards commences at coordinate 544646E, 8722822 North of the bridge on Kapembere River on M9 Road. Then it follows M9 Road to a coordinate 544996E 8726572N. Then follows a road Westerly into a stream which flows into Kapembere River at coordinate 540589E 8726138N. Then it follows Kapembere River north westerly flows into South Rukuru River. Then it follows South Rukuru River Northerly to the confluence of South Rukuru River and Kapando River which is also a Traditional Authority boundary between Traditional Authority Chindi and Mpherembe and also a constituency boundary.

1.10. MZIMBA KAFUKULE

The constituency has projected eligible voter population of 41, 964

The boundary for the constituency commences at a point North of Engucwini Trading Centre at coordinate 590049E, 8763023N to a galley South Easterly at coordinate 591030E, 8762170N then Southerly to T309 Road then crossing Katenthwolo River to Kasitu River then South Westerly following Kasitu River to the confluence of Kasitu and Kanyawayi River then Southerly following Kanyawayi River to a road which connects Kanyawayi F.P.School and Emoneni F.P.School at coordinate 571699E, 8715858N then it continues with the road Southerly to Emoneni FP School to S107 and follows the said road North Westerly and turns into S106 Road Westerly then joins T312 Road to coordinate 560084E, 8723171N then it follows a footpath North Westerly to a stream and to another road at coordinate 558781E, 8724423N then follows the said road South Westerly to a coordinate 558388E, 8724228N . Thence it follows a footpath Northerly to the mouth of Kamubanga River at coordinate 558467E, 8724920N, then it follows Kamubanga River North Westerly to coordinate 551875E, 8727923N then it follows a footpath which is to the West of Kamubanga F.P. School to North Easterly to coordinate 553639E, 8729010N then follows a footpath Easterly to a stream and follows the said stream North Easterly to coordinate 555660E, 8730274. Then it follows S106 again Northerly to a coordinate 553082E, 8732715 then it follows a road Northerly to Mzambazi Bridge at coordinate 553985E, 8734772N then it follows Mzambazi river north westerly to coordinate 550392E,

8736241N. Then it follows a footpath Northerly to a stream at coordinate 550774E, 8737002N then it follows that stream North Easterly to coordinate 552013E, 8737598 then it follows a straight line North Westerly to a footpath at coordinate 551410E, 8738688N then follows that footpath South Westerly to a road at coordinate 551337E, 8738607N then follows the said road North westerly to the mouth of Kavuwo River at coordinate 551132E, 8739031N then follows Kavuwo road to M9 Bridge then go northerly on M9 up till Kapando Trading Centre then North Easterly at Kapando School and northerly to rejoin the M9 to a stream at coordinate 560380E , 8750346N to Manthulo River at coordinate 559324E, 8749221N then it follows Manthulo River Southerly to Traditional Authority boundary point of Traditional Authorities Chindi, Mtwalo and Mpherembe. It follows the boundary between Traditional Authorities Mpherembe and Mtwalo Easterly and Northerly to coordinate 572341E, 8757426N then follow a footpath to a road at coordinate 572441E, 8757455N then follows the road Southerly to a coordinate 572510E, 8756933N then South Easterly crossing a stream at coordinate 573365E, 8755955N to a footpath Southerly, Easterly then North Easterly to coordinate 577015E, 8756666N then follows a road North Easterly to another road that connects Thandeka F.P.School and Elunyeni School follows that road Southerly crossing Gonela |River to coordinate 578430E, 8756737N following a footpath to Chavulumiska River Northerly and North Esterly cutting through a hill down a footpath to coordinate 581430E, 8759334N. Thence follows a footpath South Easterly crossing Mulalaji River to coordinate 584665E, 8756818N then follows another footpath South Easterly to Engucwini Road, T308 at coordinate 586550E, 8758080N following the said road North Easterly to a stream North Westerly at coordinate 588743E, 8761349N;

thence takes a straight line North Easterly to the commencement point North of Engucwini Trading Centre at coordinate 590049E, 8763023N

KAVUNGUTI WARD AND EZONDWENI WARD

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 18, 684

(ii) **Ezondweni Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 23, 280

The boundary between the two wards commences at the (Matala FP School to Mphimbi FP School road intersection with TA Boundary) boundary between traditional Authorities Mpherembe and Mtwalo at coordinate 567008E, 8741102N then Southerly following a road joining S107 at Mphimbi F.P. School then following the said road Southerly to coordinate 569255E, 8734214N then follows a road Easterly which connects Kapangamawe F.P. School and Elangeni F.P. School. Thence Northerly to the confluence of Ruvwere and Kasitu Rivers, which is also the constituency boundary.

1.11. MZIMBA NORTH EAST

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 47, 696

The boundary for the constituency commences at the confluence of Chamono and Lukonkhowe Rivers, following Chamono River Easterly then Kasitula River Easterly to coordinate 602979E, 8753985N then it follows a stream Easterly and cuts through a mountain to the district boundary with Nkhata Bay at coordinate 609949E, 8754200N then it follows District boundary Southerly to Mzuzu City Boundary going North Westerly and South Westerly to a stream north of Kajiti River at coordinate 603432E, 8731619N, following the stream Westerly to coordinate 602043E, 8731249N. Then it follows a footpath Southerly to Kajiti River at coordinate 602300E, 8730040N continue to follow Kajiti River then leaves Kajiti River to follow a stream Westerly to coordinate 599131E, 8729615N then it follows a footpath to Kanjoka River at coordinate 598822E, 8729924N thence following Kanjoka River South Westerly to coordinate 598194E, 8729730N then follows a footpath North Westerly which is enjoined to a stream which flows to Matuli River at coordinate 597399E, 8730643N, then follows Matuli River North Easterly to coordinate 598652E, 8732244N then follows a stream Westerly to follow a road which connects Chipapa F.P. School and Enyezeni F.P. School then takes a straight line to the Traditional Authority Boundary of Kampingo Sibande and Mtwalo at coordinate 593874E, 8732586N. Then it follows the said Traditional Authority boundary South Westerly to the confluence of Kasitu and Chipandu Rivers, then it flows Kasitu River North Easterly to a stream at coordinate 591065E, 8753250N then it follows a stream South Easterly to a mountain then Easterly straight to Kasuruwa River, following Kasuruwa River Northerly

to the confluence of Kasuruwa River and Chamono being the commencement point of the boundary description.

EKWENDENI WARD AND LUSANGAZI WARD

Ekwendeni Ward to the North and Lusangadzi to the South of the Constituency

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 27, 432

The boundary between the two wards commences at the confluence of Kasitu and Kafurufuru Rivers, Southerly to Lunyangwa River , South Easterly following Lunyangwa River to a bridge on Lunyangwa River at coordinate 595617E, 8741606N then follows a road Northerly to coordinate 596013E, 8742069N then it follows a stream South Easterly to a road from Ekwendeni CDSS at coordinate 596526E, 8741900N then it follows the road Southerly and South Easterly parallel to a stream then it joins another road Southerly which connects Ekwaiweni F.P.

School and Dunduzu FP School Southerly and Easterly respectively to M1 Road then Mzuzu City boundary, which is also the constituency boundary.

1.12. **MZIMBA WEST CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 46, 282

The boundary for the constituency commences at the confluence of South Rukuru River and Lumphangara River, Easterly then Northerly following South Rukuru River to coordinate 580567E, 8776296N, Easterly following a footpath at coordinate 581523E, 8776284N then it follows that road Southerly to the junction with T309 then turning Easterly half a kilometre to Katowa F.P. School. It follows another road Southerly to coordinate 582298E, 8768987N then it follows a road South easterly crossing a stream to coordinate 583496E, 8767050N. Then following a footpath South Westerly to Thukutu stream following a road to coordinate 584887E 8764899N, then Southerly it follows a parallel road to Mulalaji River then crossing Mulalaji River, following a road to coordinate 581813E, 8759000N. Then it follows a footpath NorthWesterly crossing Mulalaji River to coordinate 581430E, 8759334N then follows a footpath South Westerly to a mountain top then South to Chavulumiska River. It then follows a footpath Westerly to Elunyeni-
Thandeka Road and follows that road North Westerly and crosses Gonela River and soon after crossing Gonela River , it follows another road South Westerly , then Westerly and North Westerly following the edge of a mountain to a road at coordinate 572510E, 8756933N then follows the road Northerly to coordinate 572441E, 8757455N then it

follows a footpath Westerly to Tchesamu River then it follows the Traditional Boundary between Mtwalo and Mpherembe , Southerly and Westerly to the point where Traditional Authorities Mtwalo, Chindi and Mpherembe meet at Manthulo River and then following Manthulo River Northerly crossing M9 Road to coordinate 560380E, 8750346N then it follows a stream South Westerly to M9 Road and follows the said road South Westerly to the bridge at Kapando River then follows the Traditional Authority boundary between Mpherembe and Chindi Westerly to the international boundary with Zambia at coordinate 536959E, 8750111N. Then it follows the international boundary, Northerly to the tip of Vwaza Marsh. Then it follows district boundary between Mzimba and Rumphi all the way to the commencement point at the confluence of South Rukuru River and Lumphangara.

MPHEREMBE WARD AND EMCISWENI WARD

Mpherembe ward is to the north of Mzimba West while Emcisweni ward is to the south of the constituency

(i) Emcisweni Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 21, 898

(ii) Mpherembe Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 24, 384

The boundary between the two wards commences at point where Traditional Authority Mpherembe and Vwaza Marsh meet at the International boundary with Zambia, then it follows Traditional Authority Mpherembe boundary with Vwaza Marsh South Easterly to the confluence of South Rukuru and Matumba Rivers. Then it follows Matumba River South Easterly to tertiary road T311 and follows the said road South Easterly to Mayura River Bridge and continue to follow the river Southerly and takes a turn to follow Manyauzi River to coordinate 566423E, 8751080N. Then it follows a straight line North Easterly crossing tertiary road T311 to Jombo River at coordinate 568027E, 8751573N, following Jombo River Southerly then leaves Jombo River to follow a stream easterly to join a road at coordinate 569291E, 8751176N, then it follows that road North Easterly to coordinate 569024E, 8751436N then it follows a footpath North Easterly into a stream that crosses Mpherembe -Ezweleni School road North Easterly then leaving the stream to follow a footpath to a road at coordinate 571840E, 8753367N which connects Ezweleni F.P. School and St Austin J.P. School then proceed to Tchesamu River at 572433E 8753458N on the constituency boundary.

1.13. **MZIMBA NORTH CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 48, 435

The boundary for the constituency commences at the confluence of Luzi River and South Rukuru Southerly following the District boundary with Rumphu and then Nkhatabay to Coordinate 609949E, 8754200N. Then turns Westerly on top of a mountain range to a

stream then to Kasitula River which flows to Chamono River and to the confluence of Chamono and Kasuruwa River, then it follows Kasuruwa River Southerly then Westerly to a mountain top follows a stream down to coordinate 591065E, 8753250N, then it follows Kasitu River North Easterly. The follows T309 Road to Engucwini and turning North Easterly after crossing Katenthowolo River to coordinate 591030E 8762170N then turns North Westerly to coordinate 590049E, 8763023N the turns South Westerly into a stream and following that stream to T308 Road, follows the said tertiary road to coordinate 586550E, 8758080N. Then it follows a road South Westerly crossing Mkarira River to coordinate 584665E, 8756818N then it follows a road North Westerly a road at coordinate 581813E, 8759000N then it follows that road through St Patricia J.P. School then crosses Mulalaji River Northerly to coordinate 584887E, 8764899N then turn on the road Westerly to Thukutu River, then follows a footpath North Easterly to coordinate 583496E, 8767050N, continues with the road North Easterly crossing a stream North Easterly and Northerly to Katowa F.P. School , then follow T309 Westerly , crossing a stream and half a kilometer to the turn Northerly following a road to coordinate 581523E, 8776284N then turning Westerly into South Rukuru River, then following South Rukuru River Northerly then Easterly and Northerly to the confluence of Luzi and South Rukuru Rivers, being the commencement point.

KASITO WEST WARD AND KASITO EAST WARD

(i) Kasito West Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 26, 088

(ii) Kasito East Ward

The ward has a projected eligible voters' population of 22, 347

The boundary between the two wards is divided by M1 Road from the North to the South of the constituency.
