



## **ELECTORAL COMMISSION**

### **CONSTITUENCY AND WARD BOUNDARY DESCRIPTIONS FOR CONFIRMATION**

#### **1. NENO**

##### **1.1. NENO NORTH CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 31,727.

*The constituency comprises most of the areas of Traditional Authorities Chekucheku and Dambe, the North Western tip of Traditional Authority Mlauli and Neno Boma.*

The constituency boundary commences at Mwetangombe Trading Centre where boundaries of Neno, Ntcheu and Balaka districts converge, thence Southerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Symon Likongwe and Chekucheku up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Symon Likongwe, Mlauli and Chekucheku converge, thence Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Chekucheku and Mlauli up to the point where it meets the Muonekera Valley, thence Westerly along the valley up to the point where it meets Mkulumadzi River, thence Westerly along the said river up to the point where it meets Chiligongolo Stream, thence Westerly along the said stream up to the point of its intersection with Neno Mission-Chilimbondo Road and its confluence with Dwale River, thence Southerly along Dwale River up to its intersection with an unclassified road at Kanganwanji Village, thence South Westerly along the said road through Chikalema II, Kumphika and Chisesa Villages up to the Neno-Mwanza district boundary, thence Northerly along the said boundary up to the point where it meets the Malawi-Mozambique international boundary, thence Northerly along the said international boundary up to where it meets the Neno-Ntcheu district boundary, thence Easterly along the said boundary up to the point where the boundaries of Neno, Ntcheu and Balaka converge at Mwetang'ombe Trading Centre, which is the commencement point.

#### **WARDS**

##### **(1) Chilimbondo Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 14,177. It is to the West of the constituency.

## **(2) Chikonde Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 17,550. It is to the East of the constituency.

The wards are demarcated by a boundary which commences at the point where the boundary between Traditional Authorities Dambe and Chekucheku meets the Neno-Ntcheu district boundary, thence Southerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Chekucheku and Dambe up to the point where it meets Mkulumadzi River, thence Southerly along the Mkulumadzi River up to its confluence with Chiligongolo Stream, which is the constituency boundary.

## **1.2. NENO EAST CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 27,059.

*The constituency comprises the whole area of Traditional Authority Symon Likongwe.*

The constituency boundary commences at a point where the boundaries of Balaka, Neno and Zomba districts converge on the Shire River, thence South Westerly along the said river to its confluence with Lisungwi River, thence Westerly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Symon Likongwe and Mlauli, thence Northerly along the said boundary up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Mlauli, Chekucheku and Symon Likongwe converge, thence North Easterly along the boundary between Traditional Authorities Chekucheku and Symon Likongwe, thence Northerly along the said boundary up to a point where the boundaries of Neno, Balaka and Ntcheu districts converge at Mwetangombe Trading Centre, thence Easterly along the Neno-Balaka district boundary up to a point where boundaries of Balaka, Neno and Zomba districts converge on the Shire River, which is the commencement point.

## **WARDS**

### **(1) Matope Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 13,061. It is to the North East of the constituency.

### **(2) Lisungwi Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 13,998. It is to the South West of the constituency.

The wards are demarcated by a boundary which commences at the intersection of T396 Road with the boundary between Traditional Authorities Symon Likongwe and Chekucheku, thence South Easterly along the T396 Road up to its junction with the M1 Road, thence South Easterly along the M1 Road up to Zalewa Roadblock, which is both the district and constituency boundary.

### **1.3. NENO SOUTH CONSTITUENCY**

The constituency has a projected eligible voter population of 23,921.

*The constituency comprises the whole area of Traditional Authority Mlauli, and small parts of Traditional Authorities Dambe and Chekucheku.*

The constituency commences at the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Symon Likongwe, Mlauli and Chekucheku converge, thence Southerly on the boundary between Traditional Authorities Symon Likongwe and Mlauli up to the point where it meets the Shire River which is also the boundary between Neno and Blantyre districts, thence Southerly along the river up to the point where the boundaries of Neno, Mwanza and Blantyre districts converge, thence Westerly along the Neno-Mwanza districts boundary up to the point where it meets Mkulumadzi River, thence North Westerly along the said river, which is also the boundary between Neno and Mwanza districts, up to the point it intersects with an unclassified road at a point 661628E, 8288711N, thence North Easterly along the said road passing through Chisesa, Kumphika and Chikalema Villages up to Dwale River, thence Northerly along the said river up to its confluence with Chiligongolo Stream, thence Easterly along the said stream up to its confluence with Mkulumadzi River, thence Southerly along the said river up to a point where it meets Muonekera Valley, thence, Easterly along the said valley up to the point where the boundaries of Traditional Authorities Symon Likongwe, Mlauli and Chekucheku converge, which is the commencement point.

#### **WARDS**

##### **(1) Ligowe Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 14,544. It is to the North of the constituency.

##### **(2) Chifunga Ward**

The ward has a projected eligible voter population of 9,377. It is to the South of the constituency.

The wards are demarcated by a boundary which commences at the confluence of Mkulumadzi and Nganjo Rivers along the Neno-Mwanza district boundary, thence Northerly Mkulumadzi along the said river up to its confluence with Msangadzi River, thence Easterly along the said river up to a point where the boundary between Traditional Authorities Mlauli and Symon Likongwe meets Msangadzi River, which is the constituency boundary.
